- Do not tighten any hardware completely unless noted.
- Passenger side installation shown.

Door Cleaning:

- Do not use Rain-X®, Plexus® or any other protector, wax, or polish.
 - Do not use window cleaning fluids (Windex, 409, etc) or any solvents (gasoline, denatured alcohol, acetone, etc).
 - Never use abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, or gritty cloths.
 - Never use razor blades, scrapers, squeegees, brushes, etc.
1. Thoroughly rinse Doors to float off dirt and mud.
 2. Using a soft cloth, or microfiber cloth, clean Doors with warm water and a gentle detergent. Baby shampoo, rubbing alcohol, or hand washing soap can also be used.
 3. To prevent water spots, use a chamois to blot Doors dry.

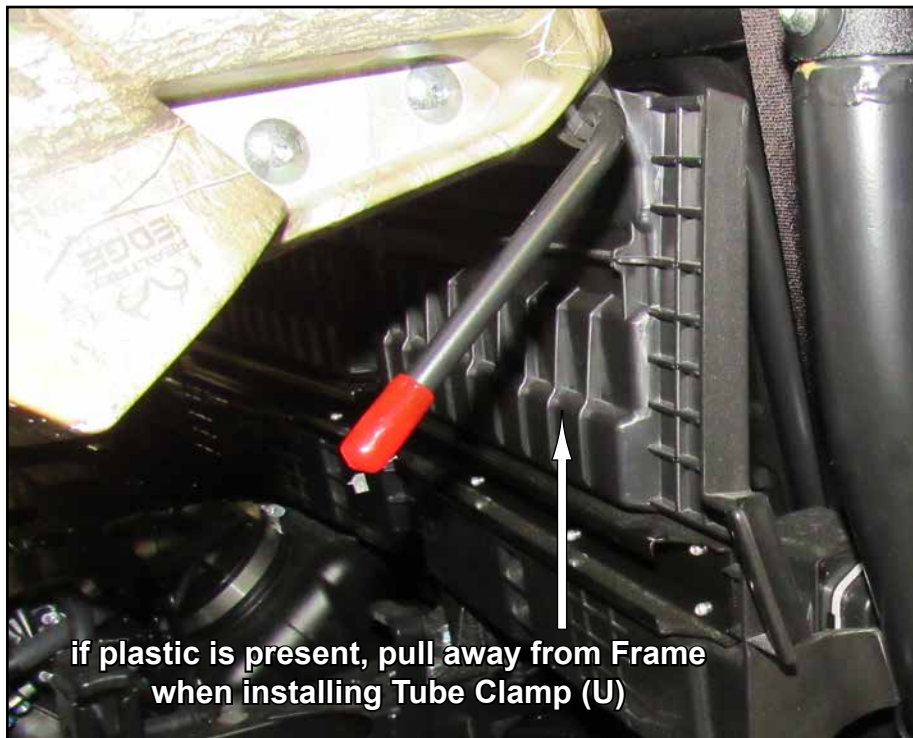
- Remove stock Doors.



- Install Right Bracket (F) and Right Striker (G) with hardware shown.



- Install Tube Clamp (U) around Cage in location shown; do not tighten hardware.
- Place Right Support (L) in location shown.

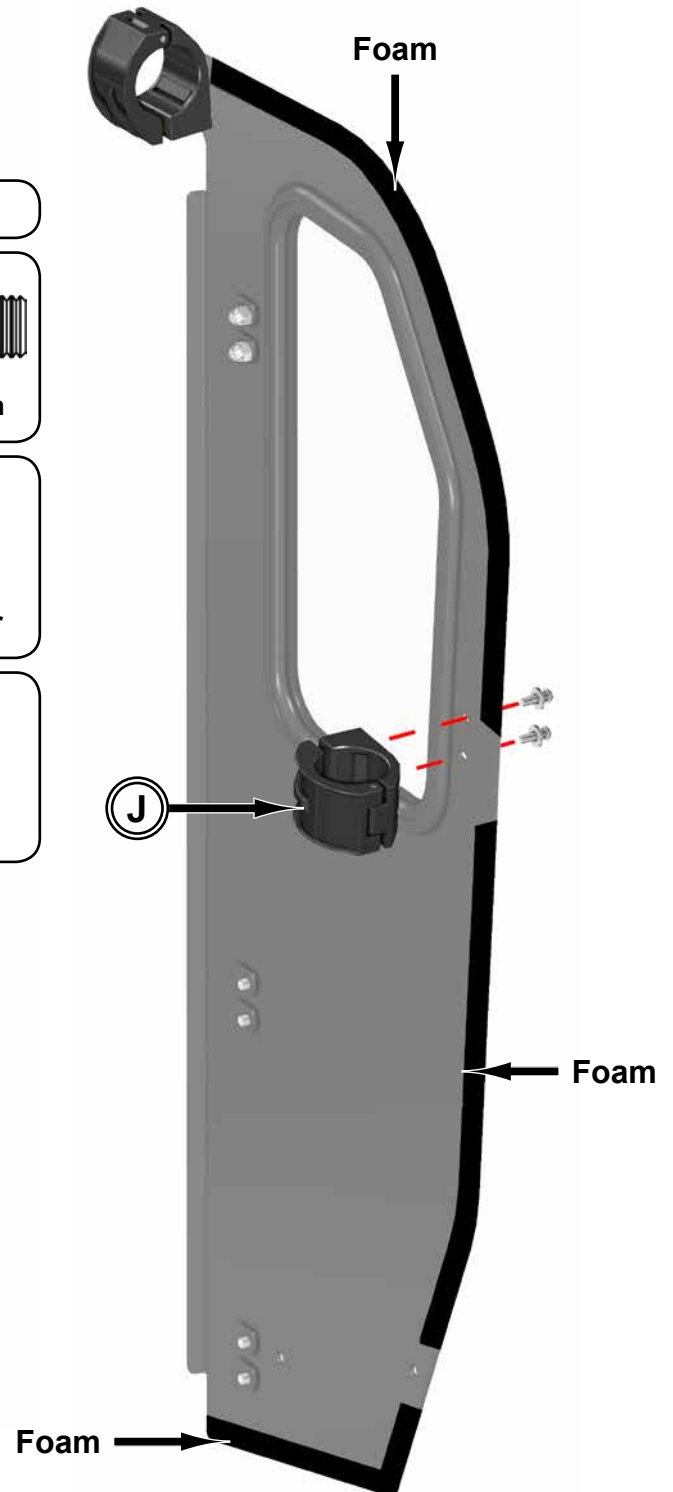


if plastic is present, pull away from Frame
when installing Tube Clamp (U)

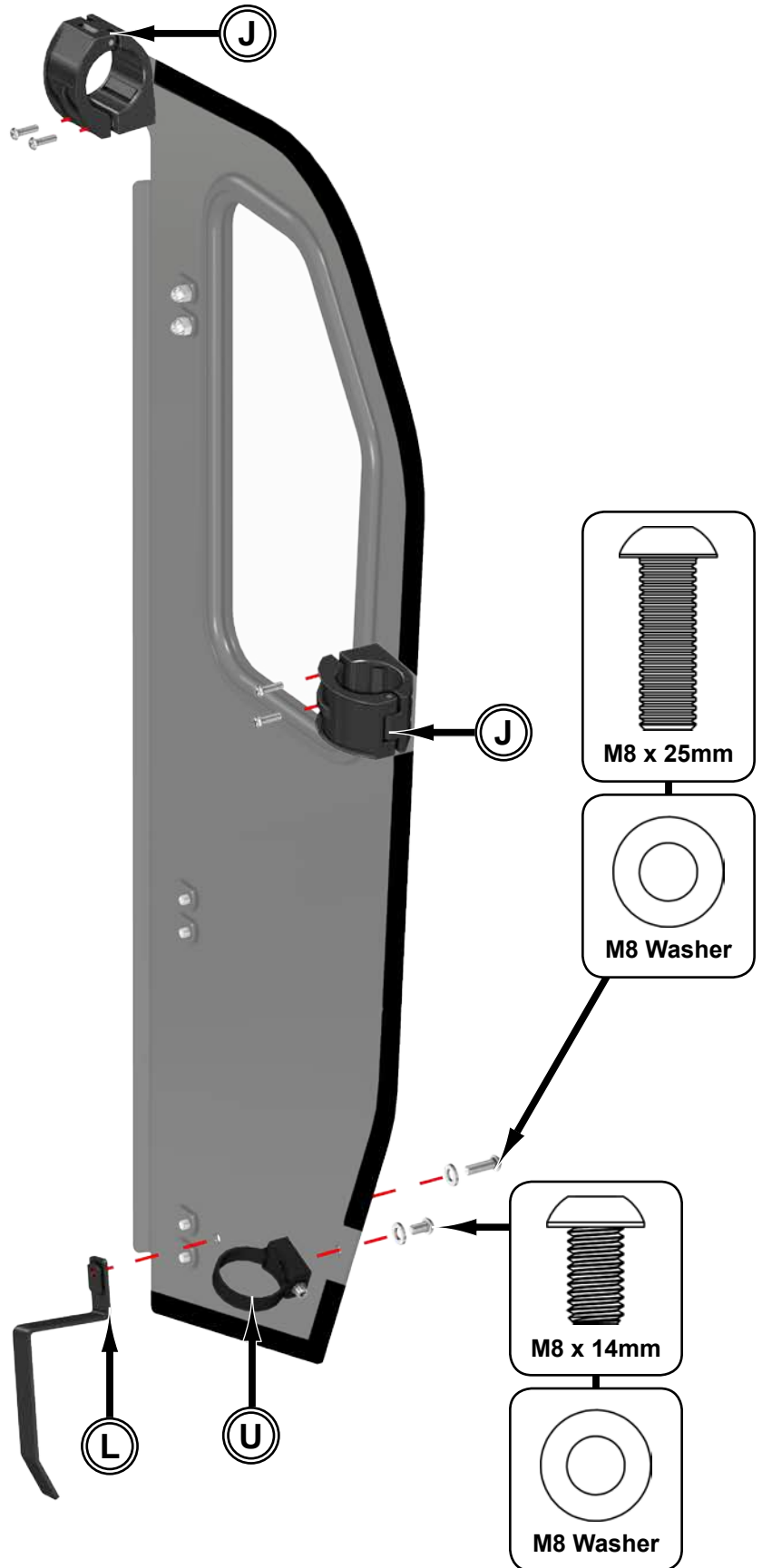
- Install Clamps (J), Right Male Hinge (D), and Right Hinge Assembly (N) to Right Hinge Mount (T) with hardware shown.



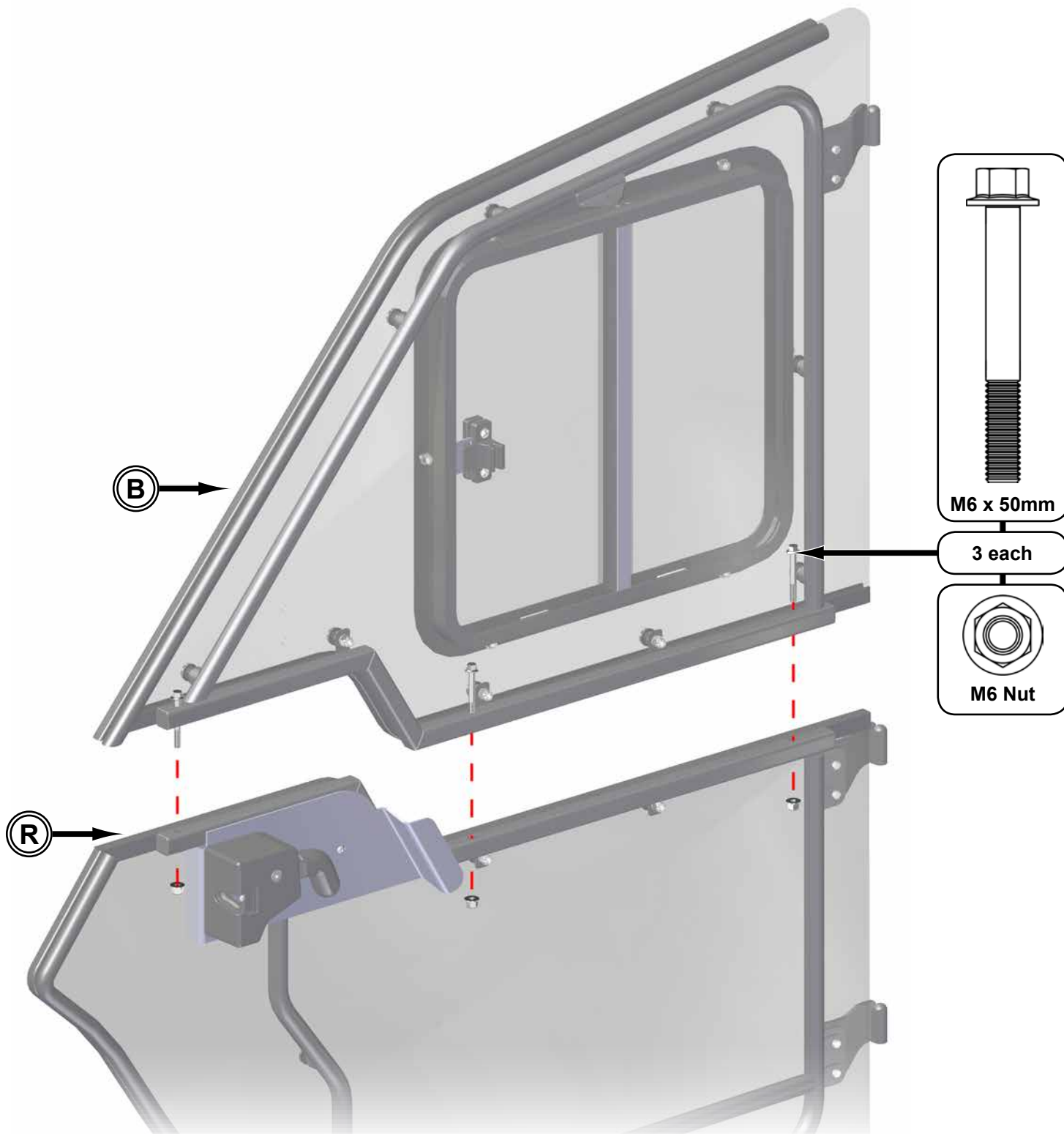
- Cut and install Foam to locations shown.



- Secure Right Hinge Mount (T) to previously installed Tube Clamp (U) and Right Support (L) with hardware shown.
- Secure Clamps (J) around Cage; use previously removed Clamps (J) hardware.
- Install Foam to location shown.



- Join Right Upper Door (B) and Right Lower Door (R) with hardware shown. Tighten hardware completely.



- Hang Door on Right Hinge Assembly (N) and Right Male Hinge (D).



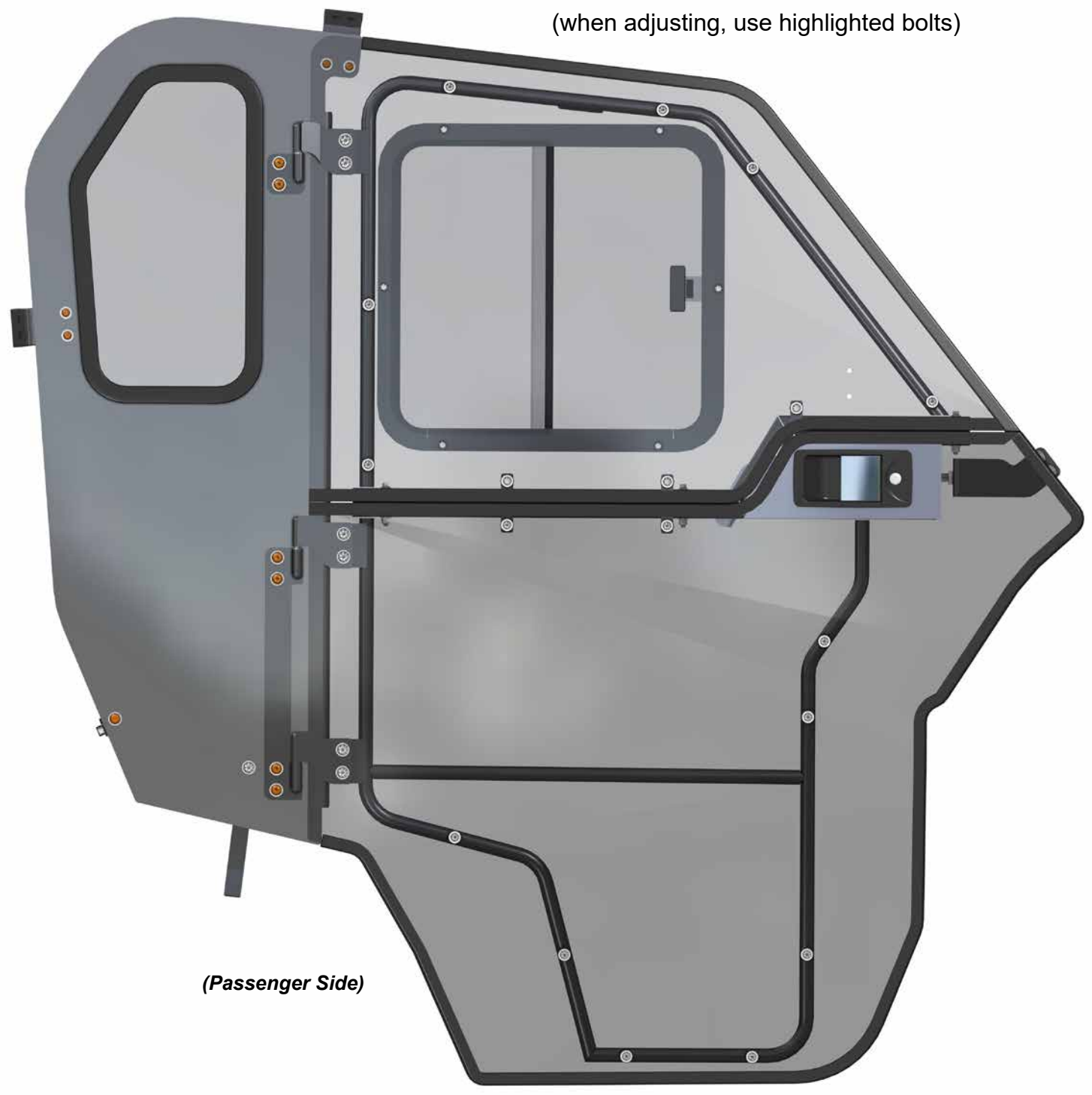
- Close Door and engage Latch.
- Align to machine and tighten all hardware completely; see following page.

(when adjusting, use highlighted bolts)

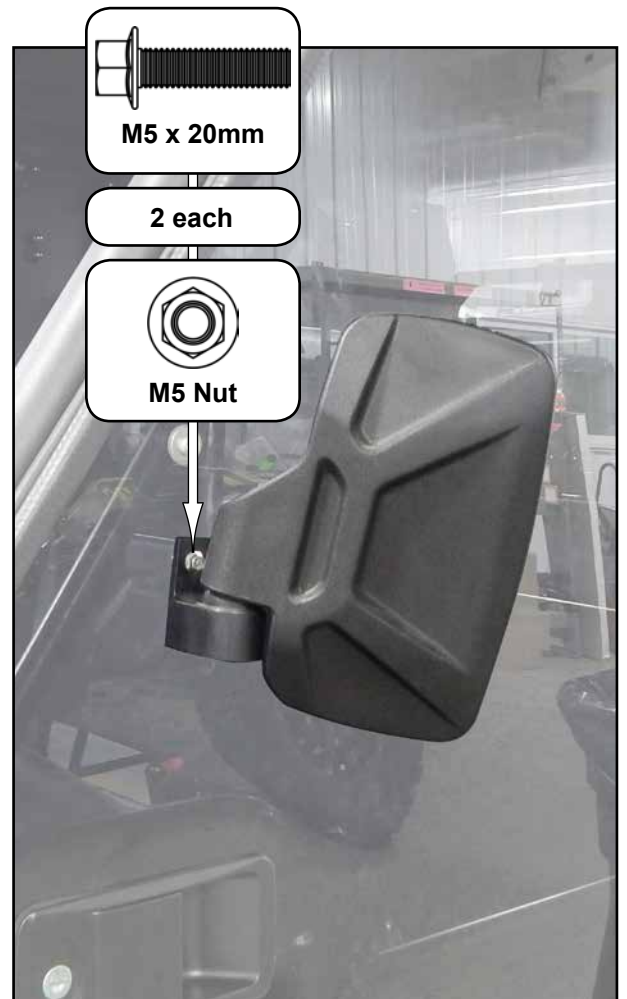
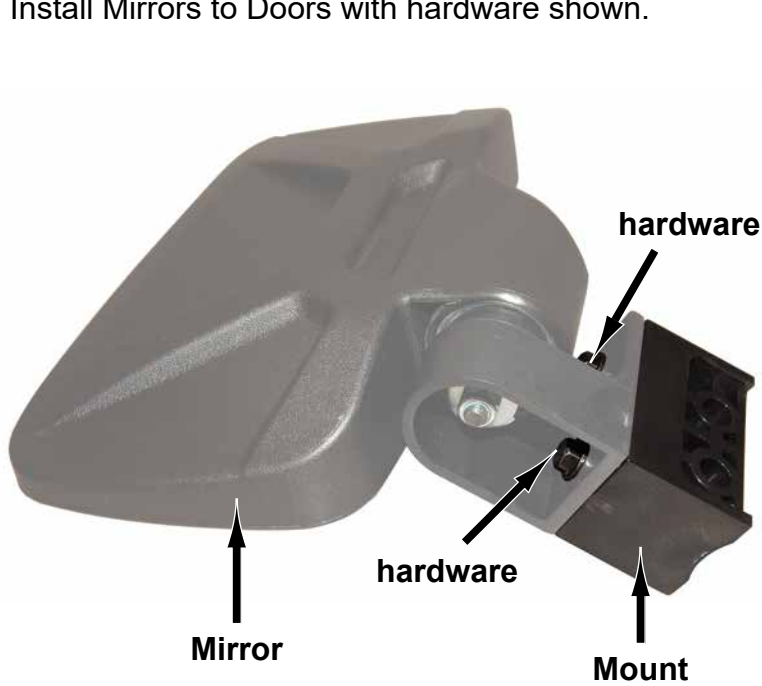

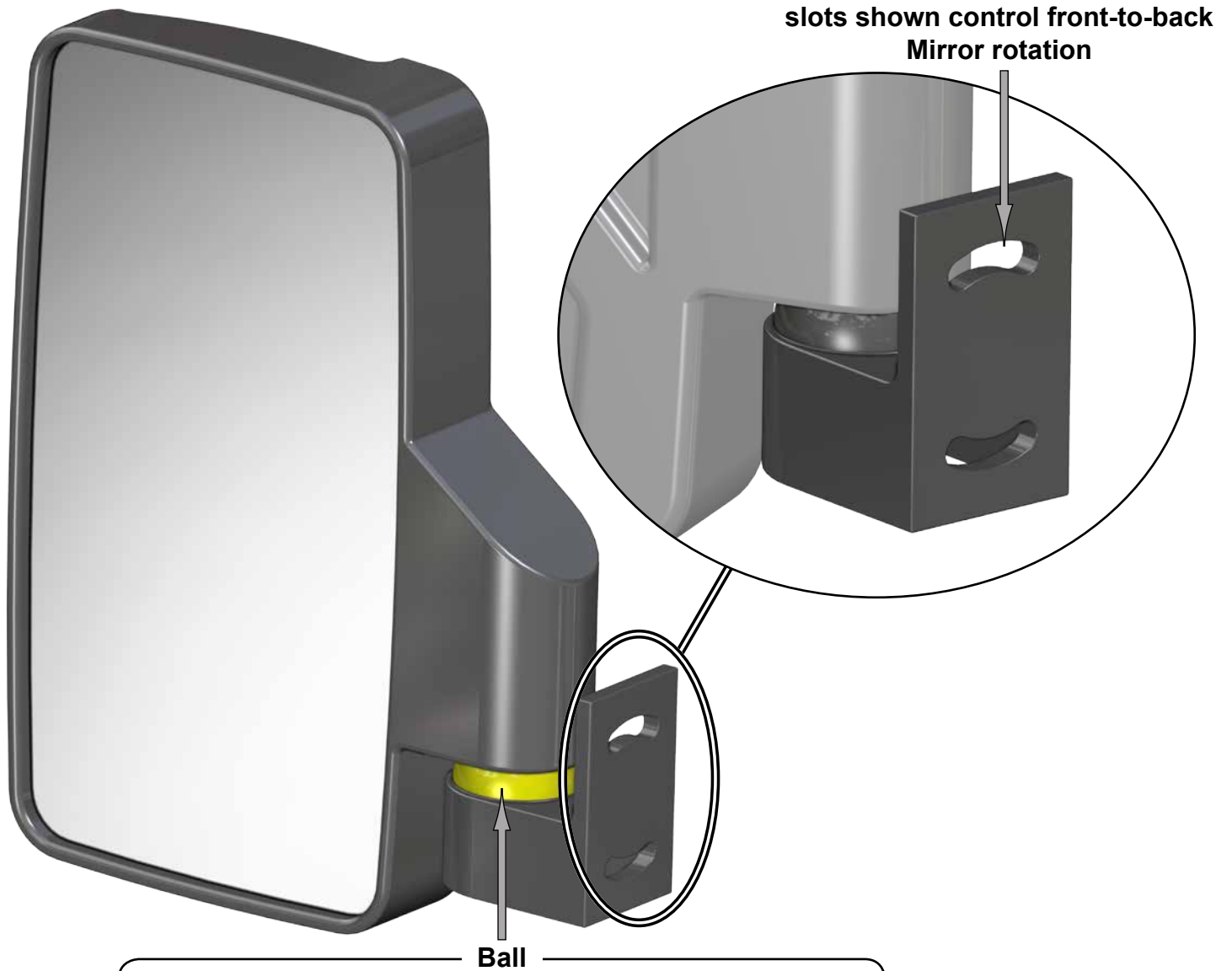
- Install Gas Strut (K) to Door and Clamp (J) with hardware shown.



- Remove installed Mounts on Mirrors. Discard Mount and hardware.
- Install Mirrors to Doors with hardware shown.



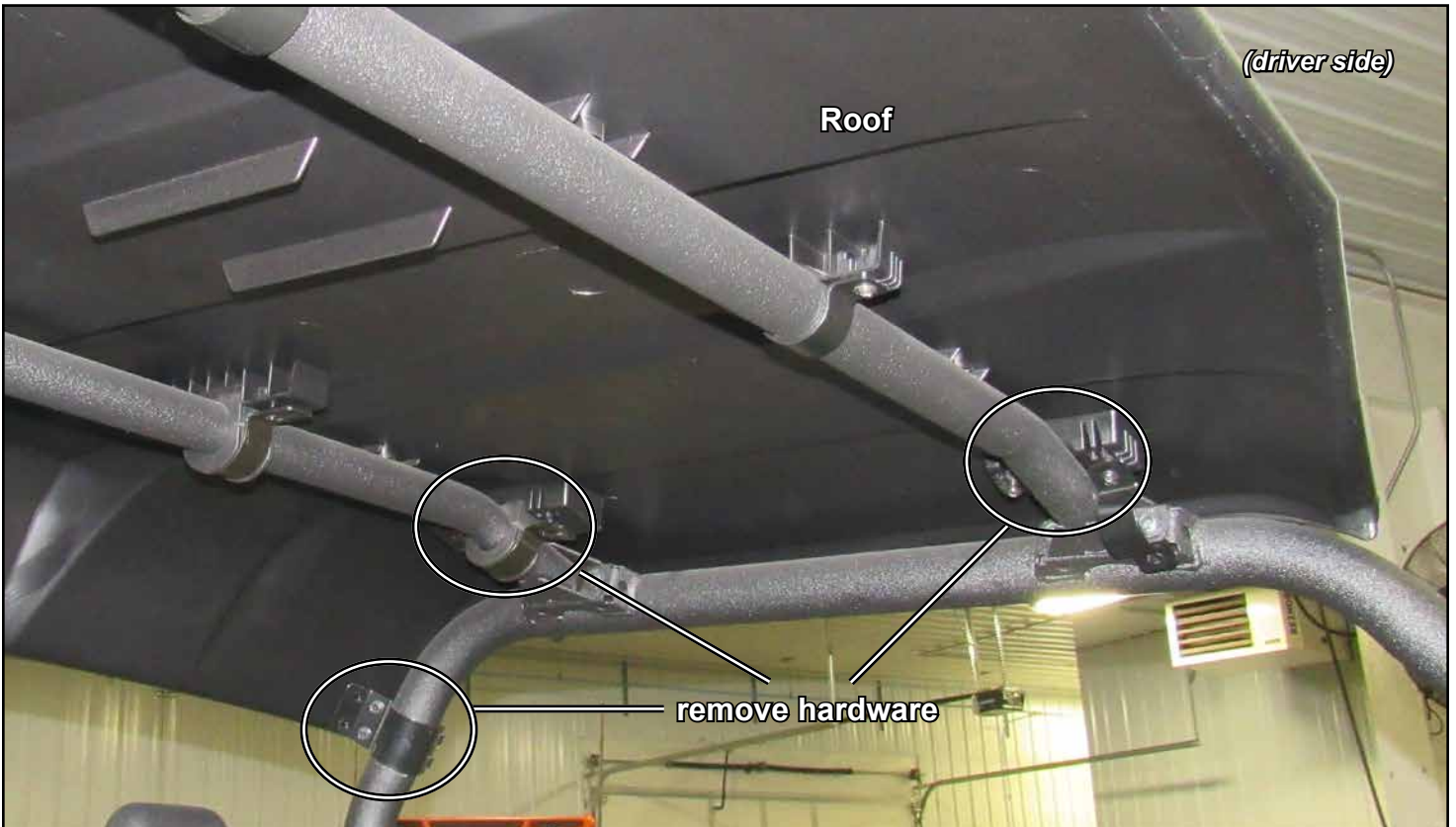
- Repeat steps for opposite side.



- Mirror is spring loaded and can also be adjusted here.
- Ball will allow adjustment in various directions.



- Remove Roof hardware shown.
- Reinstall after Foam has been installed.



- Install Foam to Cage in locations shown.
