




To Rack and Pinion

- Remove stock Tie Rods from machine.
- Remove Jam Nuts from Ball and Sockets.
 - Install Ball and Sockets to Rack and Pinion. Use Loctite.
- Install Boots to Rack and Pinion and secure with Zip Ties. Use a lubricant to ease installation.
- Reinstall Jam Nuts to Ball and Sockets
- Install Tie Rod Shafts to Ball and Sockets.
- Install Tie Rod Ends to Tie Rod Shafts
- Secure Tie Rod Ends to same location as stock on Spindles with hardware shown.




- Before initial ride, set toe-in of vehicle.

- After initial ride check to see that hardware remained tight.


