




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Front Windshield: IN-FWS-K-MULEFXR





 The first thing you need to do is install the two side latches onto the windshield assembly. One on each side. You will install them using the M6x25 Sealing Washer Bolt, Item "A" and the M6 Nylock Nut, Item "C" provided in your kit. See Fig.1.



 Next, install the Support Bracket-3 form your kit. It will be a little curved so the windshield conforms to it. You will install it using the M6x20 Seal Washer Bolt, Item "D" and M6 Nylock Nuts, Item "C" also provided in your kit. See Fig.2.




 After the bracket is installed, now you can install the Rubber Bulb Seal all along the 3 sides of the windshield and cut to fit if needed. See Fig.3.









6. Once the Bulb Seal is installed, now install the "D" Shaped Rubber Seal along the lower frame of the upper windshield. This is an Adhesive seal, so remember to peel the backing off before applying. See Fig.6.





7. Now you will need to install the "Lower Universal Clamps" to the side vertical frame bars as the windshield has the "Upper Clamps" already installed previously. You will use the bolts already in the clamps to install around the side frame bars. Leave a little loose for adjustment later. Then you will mount the Latch Lock Mount Bracket to the clamps using the M8x16 Button FT Bolts, Item"F".

After the bracket is mounted you can install the Latch Block Mount to the bracket using the M6x20 Button Head Bolts from the Latch Kit as shown in Fig.7.







8. Next, install the three Tube Clamps, Item "G" on the top cross bar as shown in Fig.8, and let them hang there for now as you will align them up to the holes in the Upper Windshield panel in the next steps. Fig.8 also shows where the clamps attach to the Upper Windshield Panel.





9. Now, to make the installation of the Upper Windshield Panel easier, you will need to remove the bolt and nut from the roof right above the cross bar where it bolts to the side frame. There is one on each side. You will reinstall after the Upper Windshield Panel is installed. See **Fig.9**.



10. After the bolts have been removed, take the Upper Windshield Panel and slip it up under the front part of the roof. Lift the roof line up to gain access, then fit it into position as shown in Fig.10-11. Look at both sides to be sure it is centered with the vehicle as good as possible and make sure the seal is seated onto the frame







11. After the the panel is in position under the roof, now attach the clamps with the gas cylinders on them to the vertical frame bars of the vehicle. They attach just like the lower ones you installed earlier. See Fig.12.







12.Now you are ready to install the Upper Windshield to the Tube Clamps you installed previously.

You will install these using the M6x25 Seal Washer Bolts, **Item "A"** and the M6 Nylock Nuts, **Item "C"**. See **Fig.13**.





13.Next, set the main windshield on the front frame and align the holes in the windshield with the hinge holes on the Upper Windshield you just put in. Thread all 6 bolts from all 3 hinges first to make sure they all go in ok before tightening them down in place. You will use the M6x25 Flat Head Bolts, Item "B" and M6 Nylock Nuts, Item "C" in your kit. Fig.14 shows installing them.


14.Once the three hinges are attached to the main windshield and bolts tightened, now look at the side Window Latches. Pull the windshield tight and see if you can lock the latch into position or not. If not, you can loosen the clamps to adjust so the Latch fits correctly into the Latch Block Mount. You will need to do both sides. Once they are both working correctly, then tighten clamps and any other items loosened for adjustment back down. See Fig.15.

15. After the latches are working

loosened to help align things together. Make sure at this point

they are all tight and snug.

16. Next, you can install the gas cylinders to the main windshield. You will use the units existing lock nut as shown in Fig.17.



17. The last thing you need to do is reinstall the two roof bolts you removed previously before you installed the Upper Windshield Panel. There was one per side, right and left and secure. See **Fig.18**.
