


## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS




Removal: Keep all components removed from machine.




Installation: Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.

- Install new Axle.
- Set Adjustment Bearing position and install Trailing Arm (A) or (B) to Frame with stock hardware.







## **Installation continued:**

- Reinstall Sway Bar to Trailing Arm with hardware shown.
- Reinstall Shock to Trailing Arm with stock hardware.
- Repeat steps for opposite side.
- Reinstall Rotors, Calipers, and Hubs.
- SEE FOLLOWING PAGE FOR BRAKE LINE REROUTING.







- Remove Bracket from Stud.
- Pass Caliper through location shown. Brake Line may need removal. Caliper will now be under Frame.
- Route to Spindle and secure Caliper.
- Secure Brake Lines with provided components shown; ensure that no binding / interference occurs.



#### Installation continued:

- Install CV Guard Clips (E) to Trailing Arms (A)(B) with hardware shown.








# **Rear Camber Adjustment:**

Bearing in this position provides positive camber (tire out at top)
