Power Flip Windshield for Polaris® General™

- Do not discard packaging until product has been successfully installed.
- While routing wires, follow factory wiring when possible and avoid rotating and/or hot components.
- Use provided wire ties and secure wires and Harnesses as needed.
- SuperATV does not recommend keeping Windshield installed while transporting on an open air trailer. Remove or secure with straps.

Optional WWK-004 Wiper Kit is shown being installed. Disregard all Wiper Kit references if not installing Wiper Kit at this time.

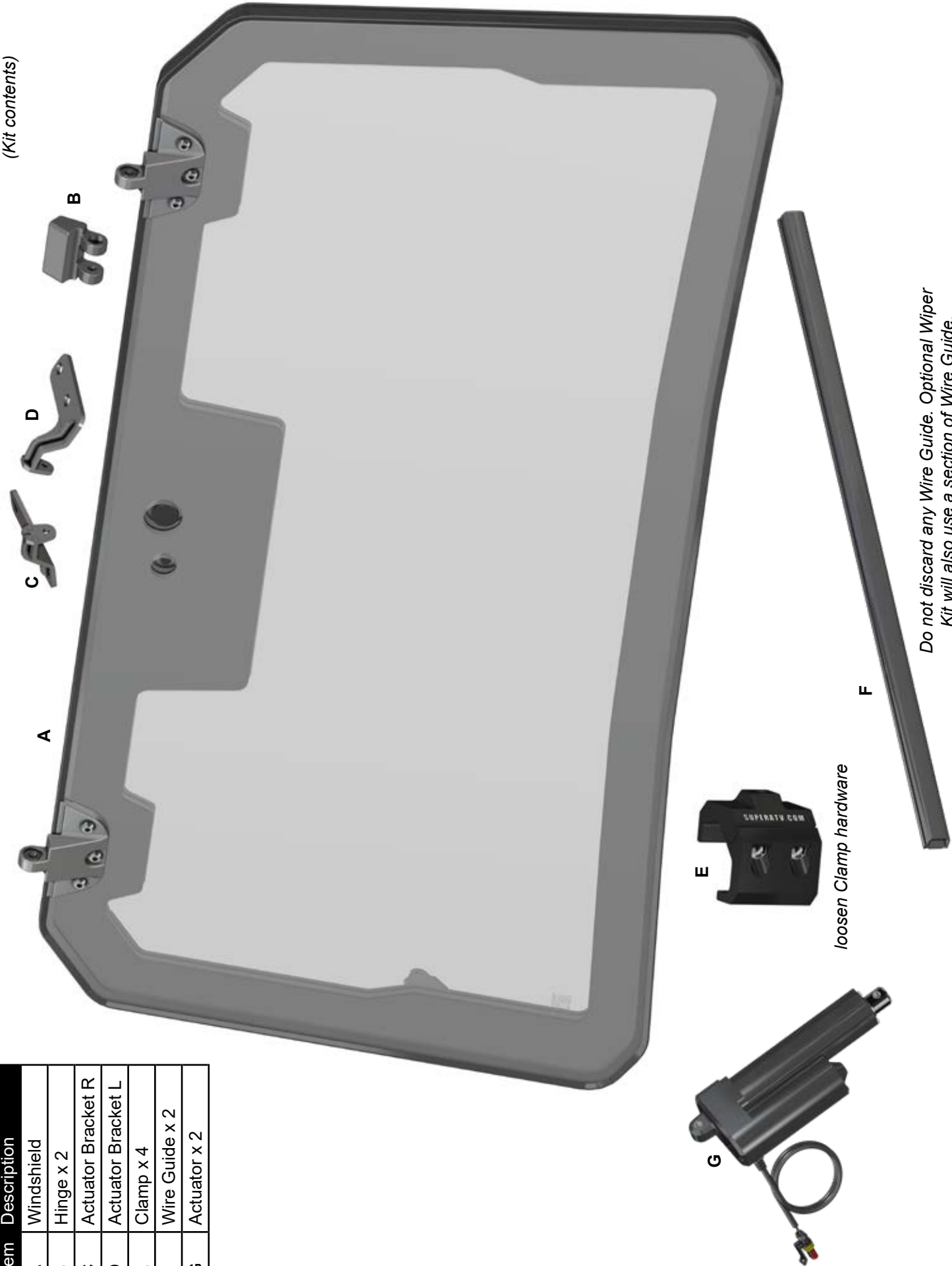

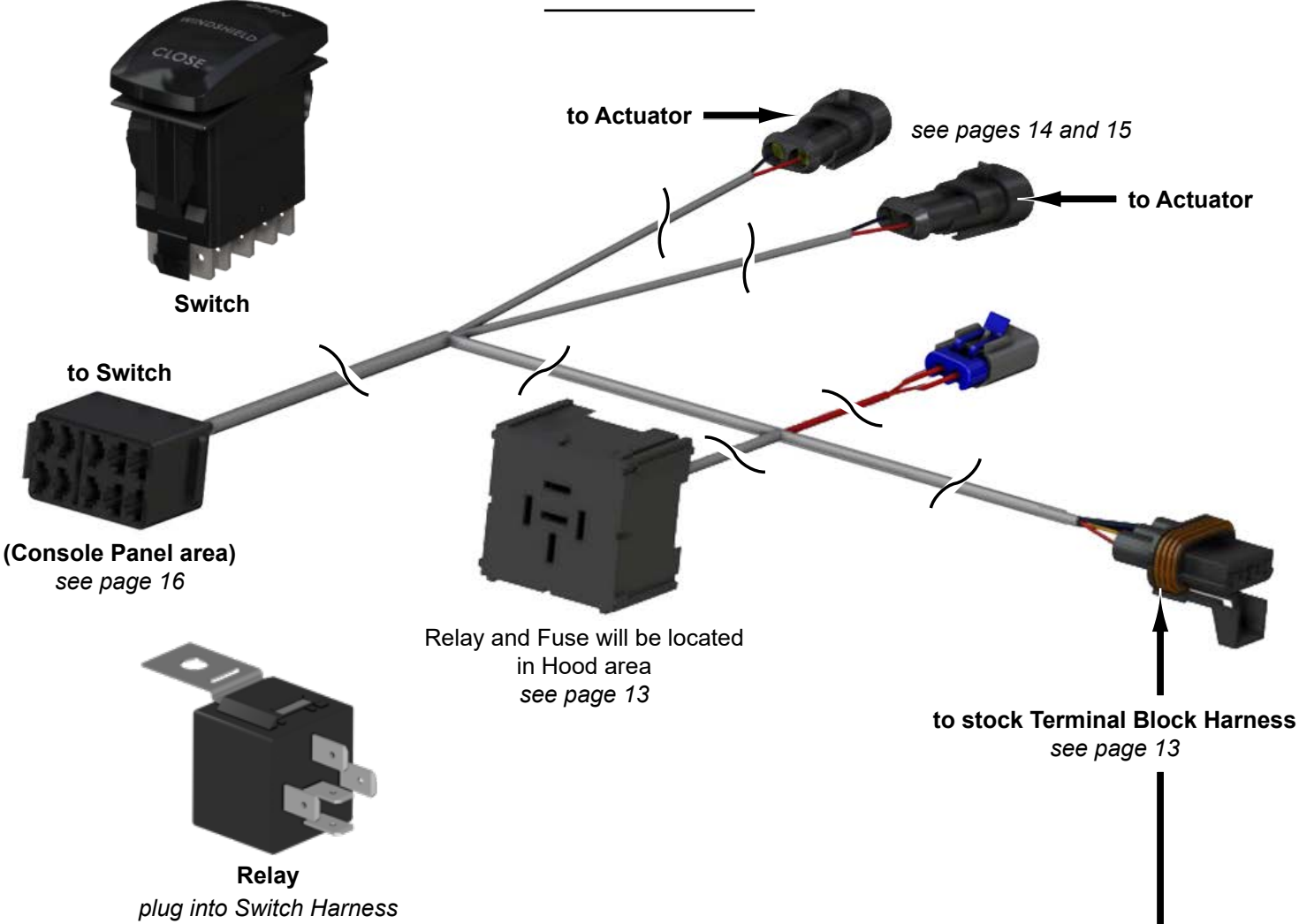

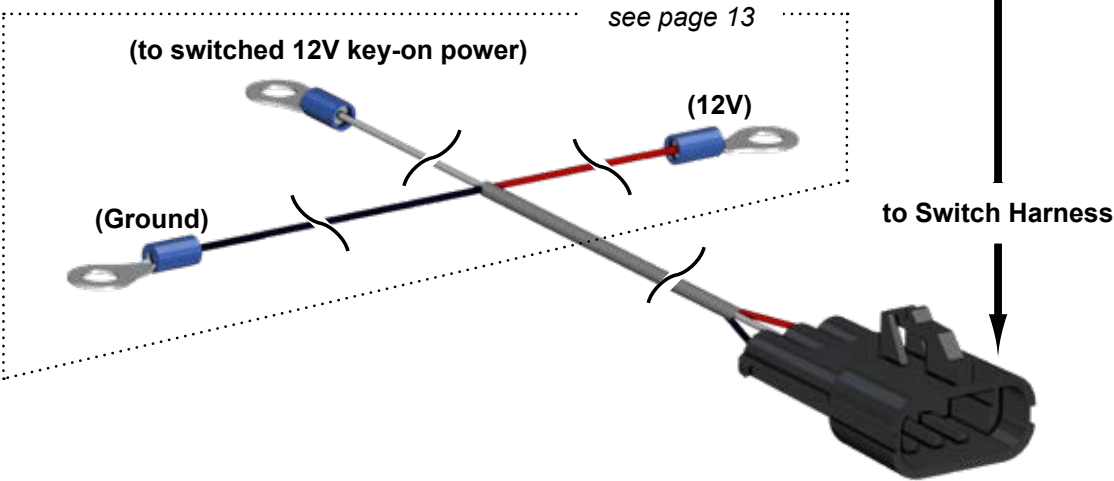


Switch Harness

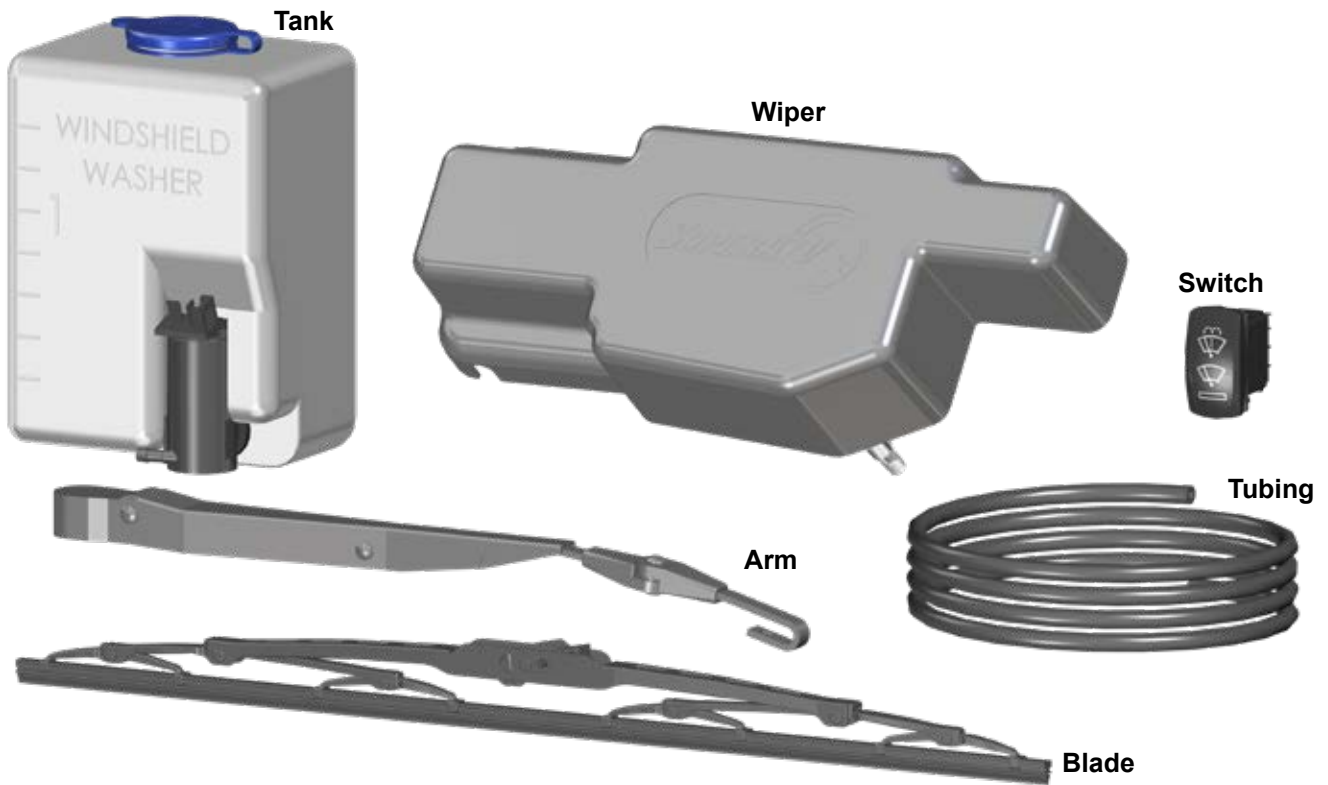


Alternate Power Harness

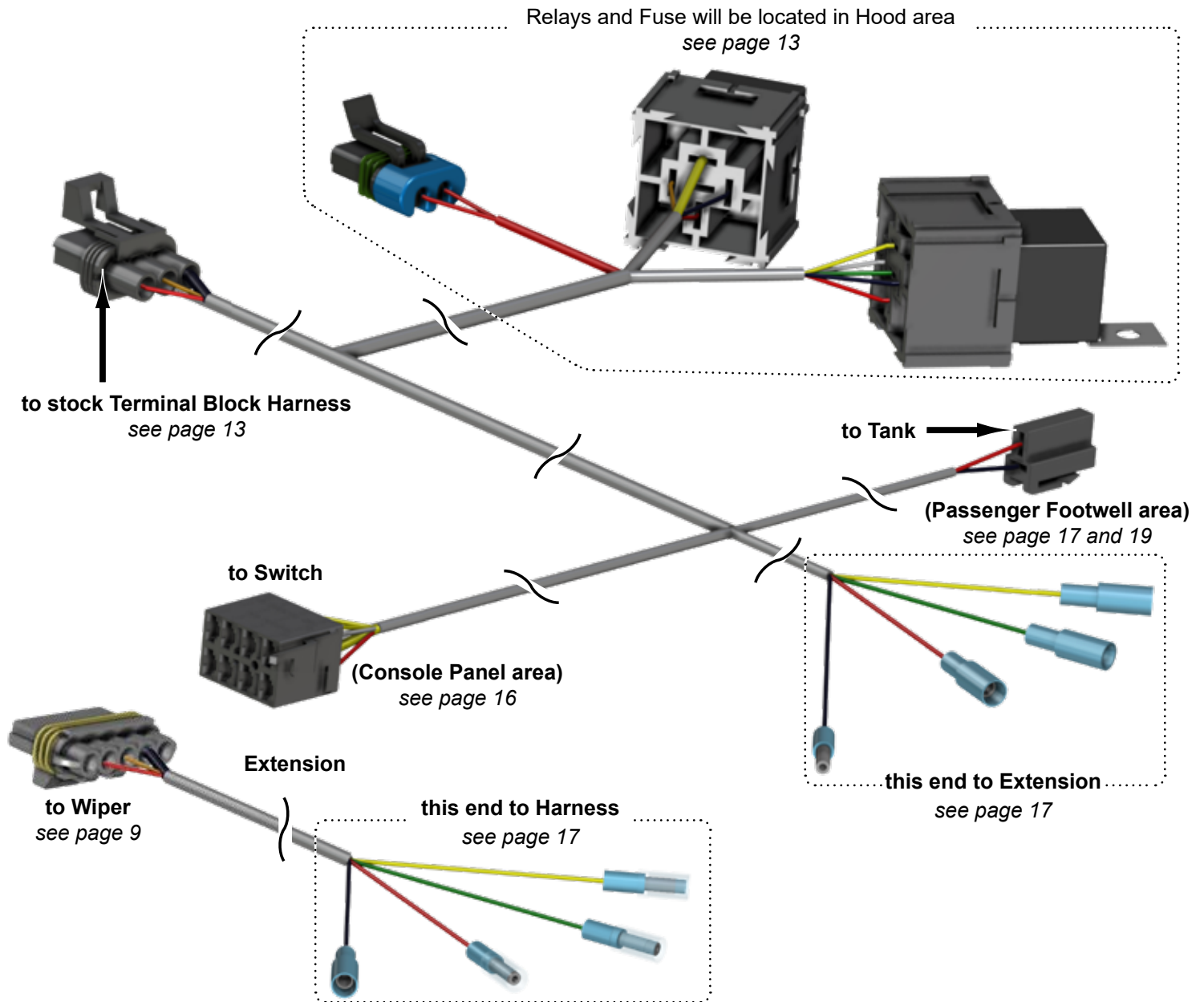

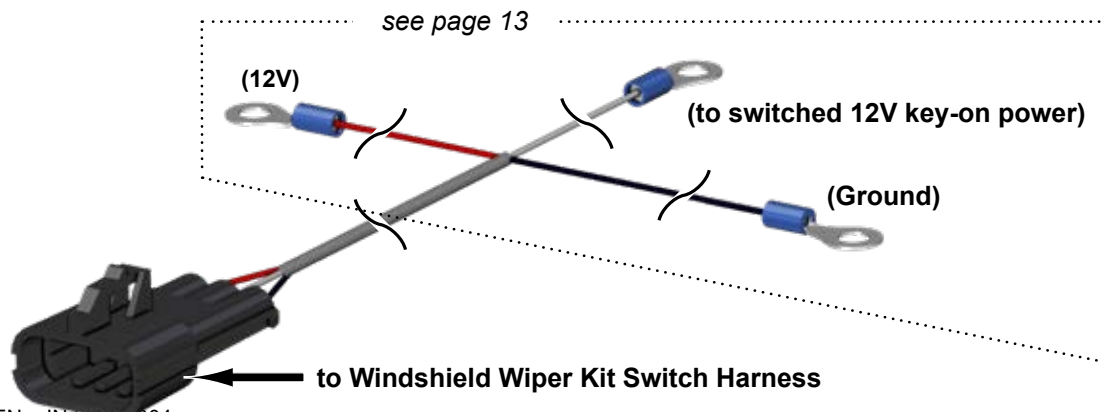


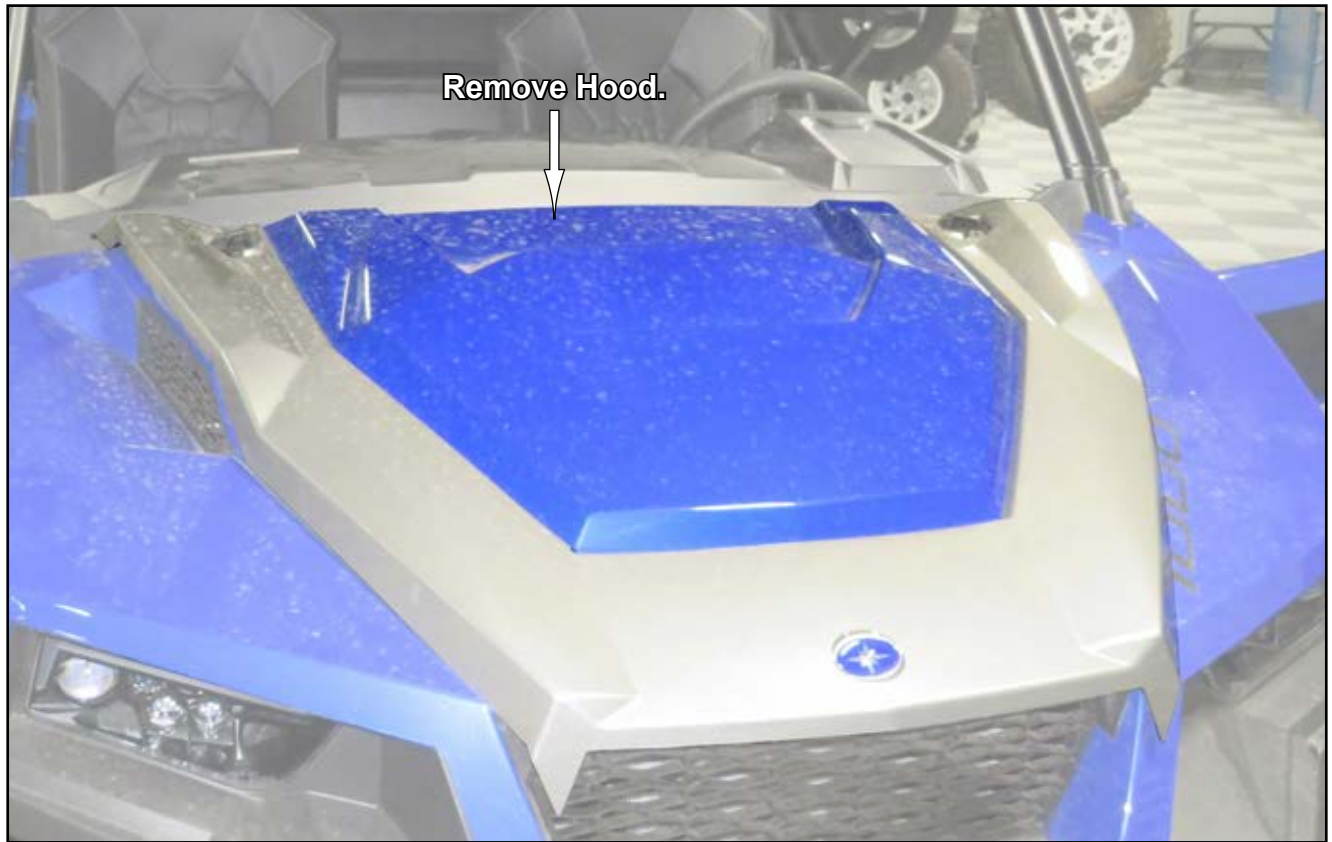
Windshield Wiper Kit Switch Harness



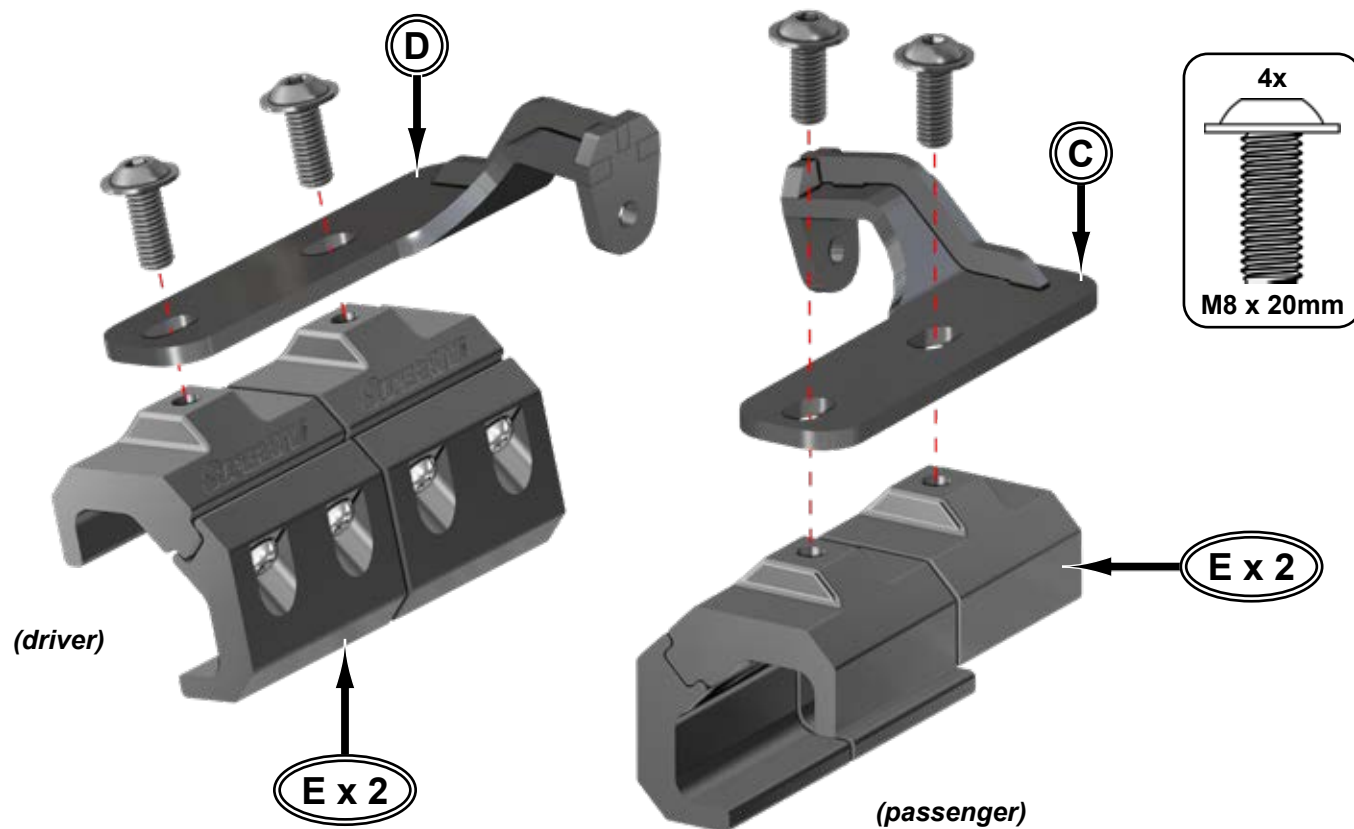
Windshield Wiper Kit Alternate Power Harness

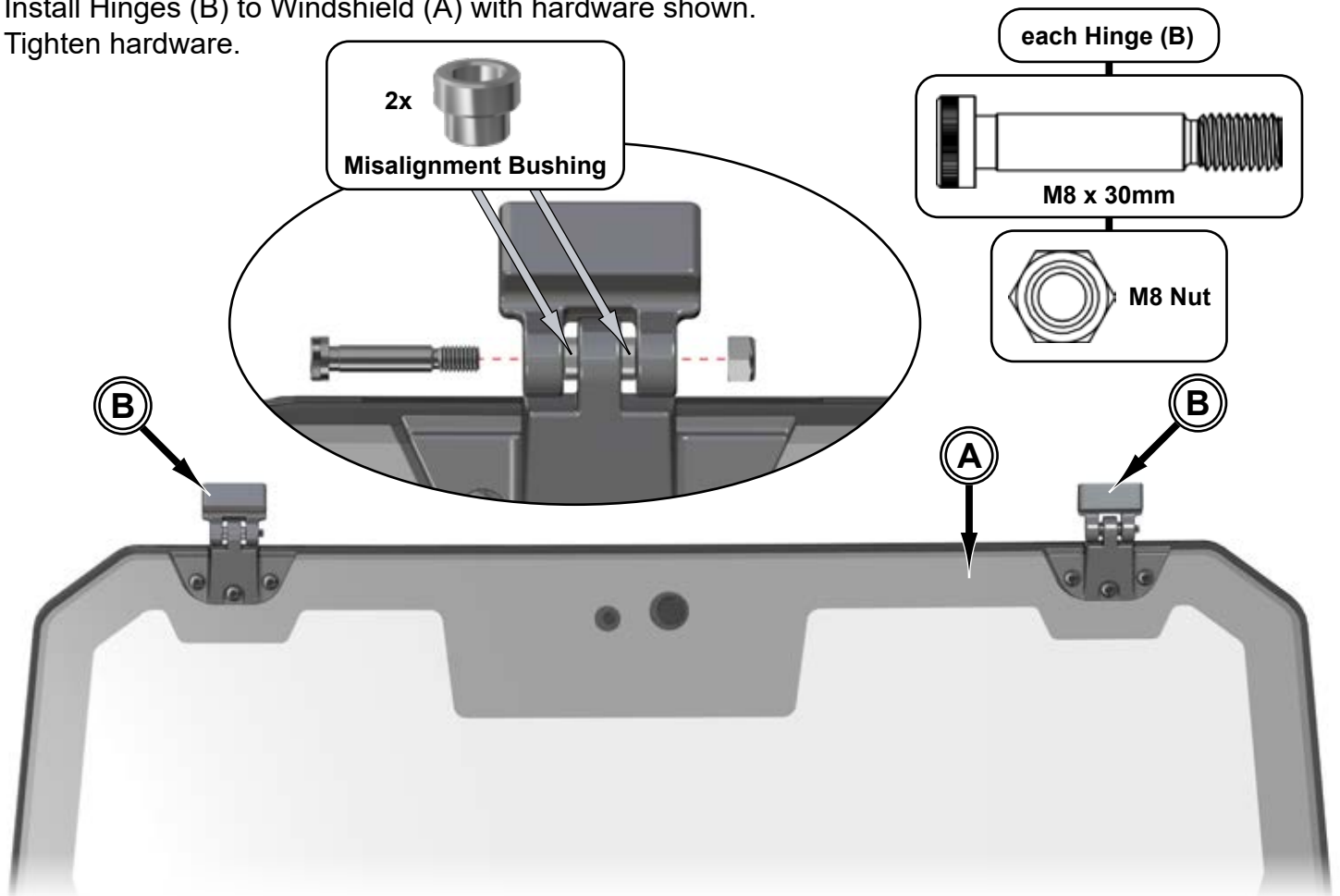
- Install Actuator Brackets (C)(D) to Clamps (E) with hardware shown; do not tighten.



- Install Actuator Brackets / Clamps to machine.
- Clamp hardware should be snug but not completely tight.

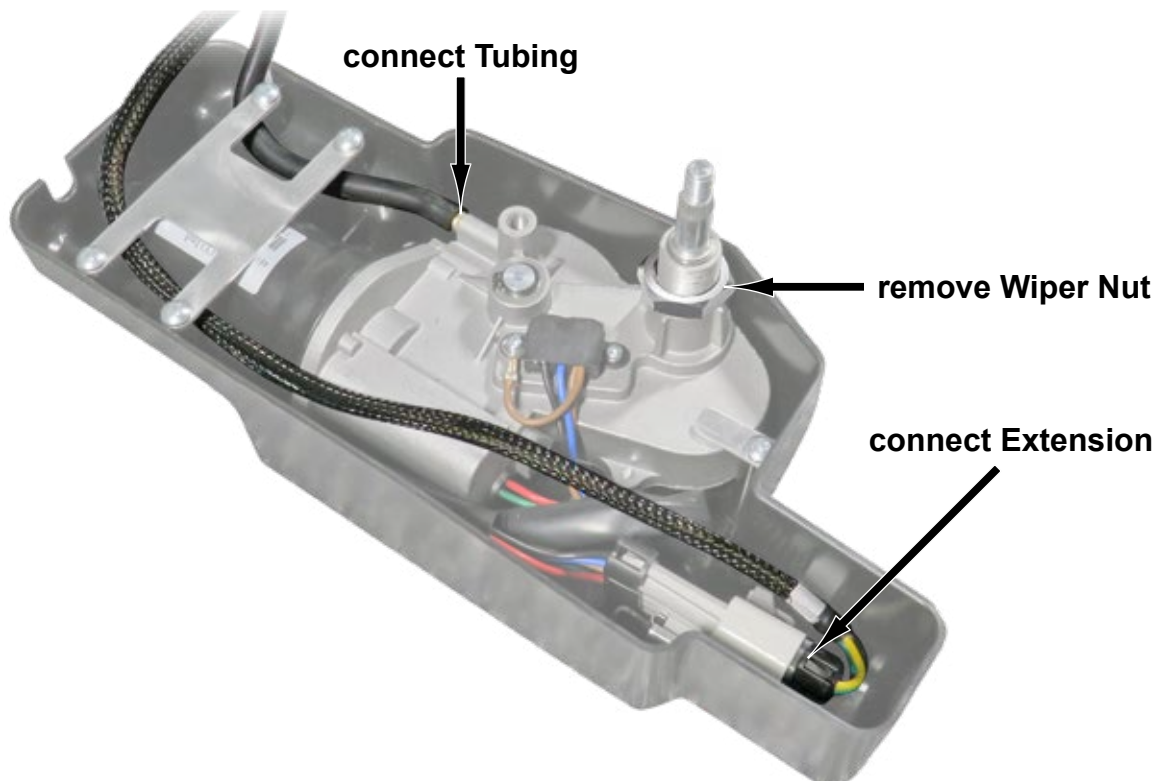


- Install Hinges (B) to Windshield (A) with hardware shown.
- Tighten hardware.



Windshield Wiper Kit only

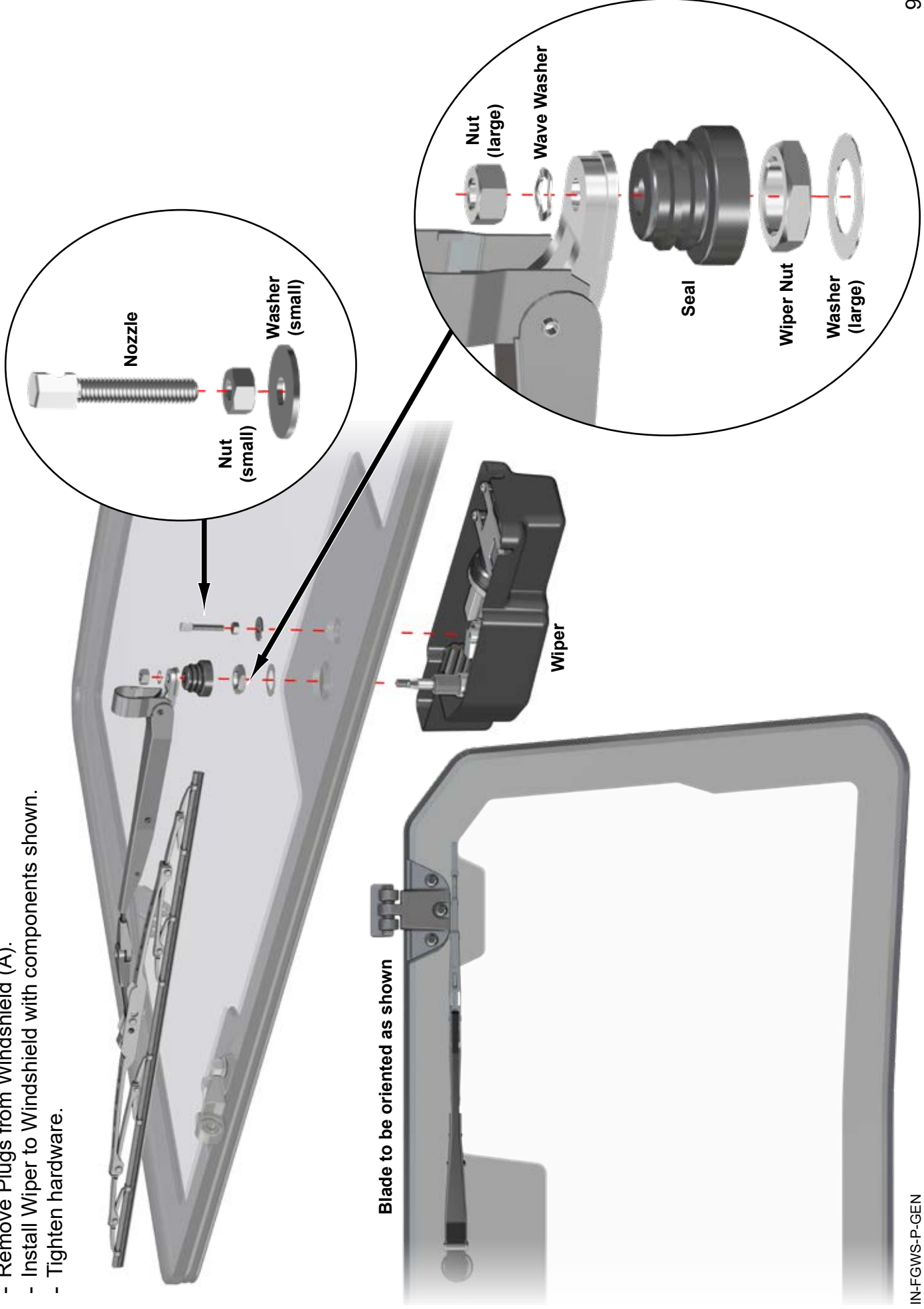
Prep Wiper as shown.

- Remove Plugs from Windshield (A).
- Install Wiper to Windshield with components shown.
- Tighten hardware.

Nozzle should face bottom of Windshield and stick out approximately 13/16".



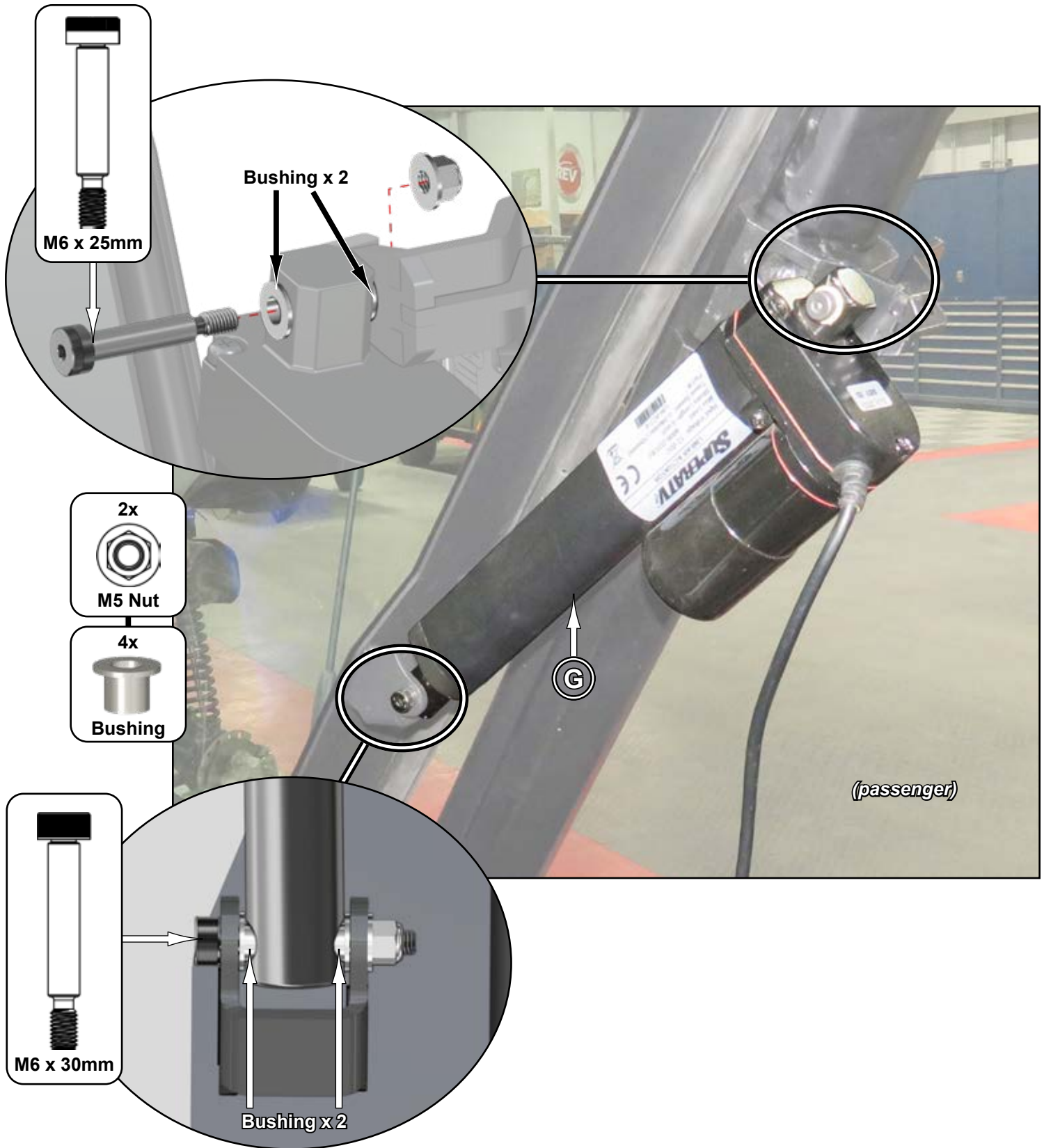
- Place Windshield (A) onto machine.



- Secure Hinges to Frame with hardware shown; do not tighten.
- Center and align Windshield assembly to machine.
- Tighten hardware.



- Secure Actuator (G) with hardware shown; tighten.
- Repeat for driver side.



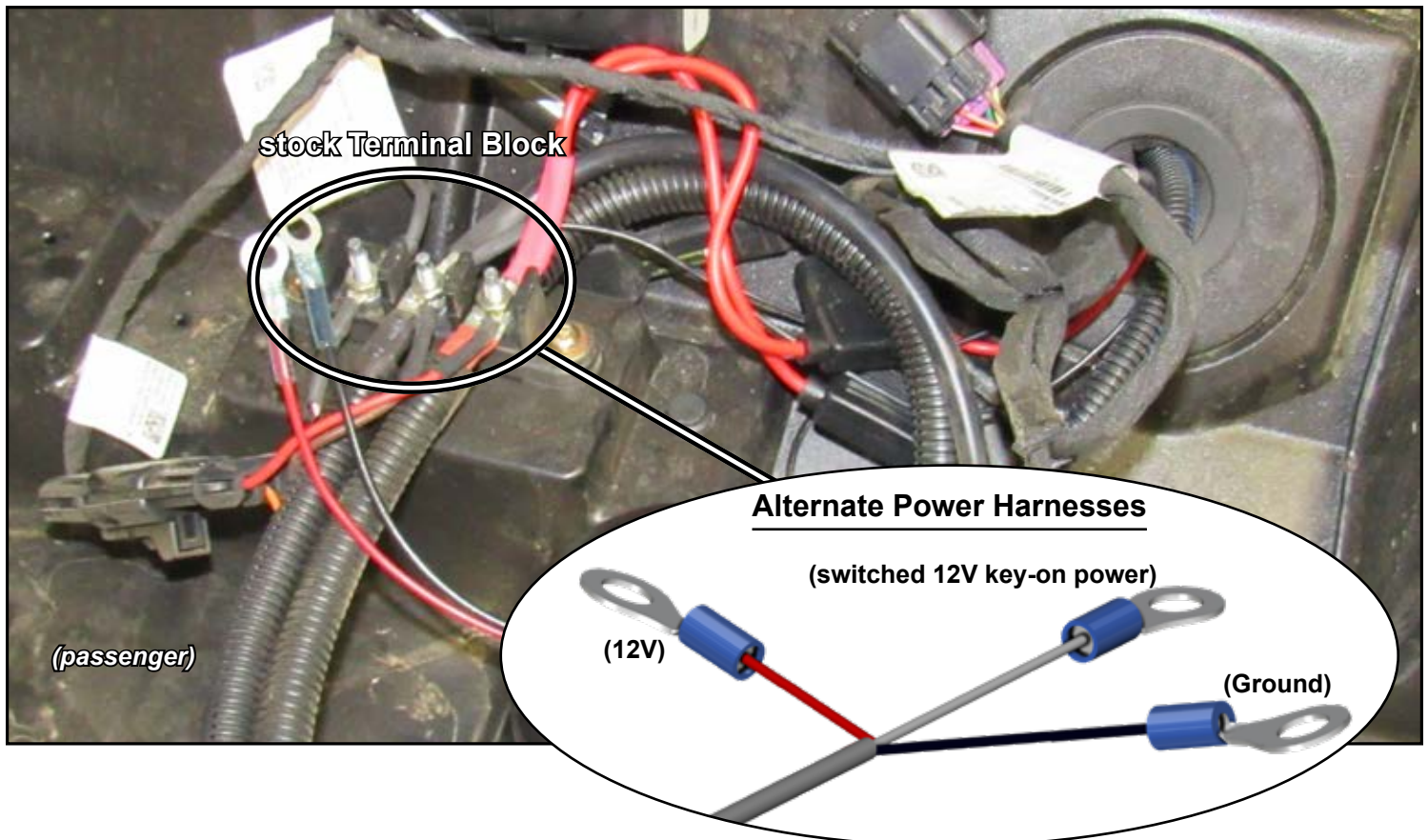


route Connectors shown through Grommet and into Upper Dash area

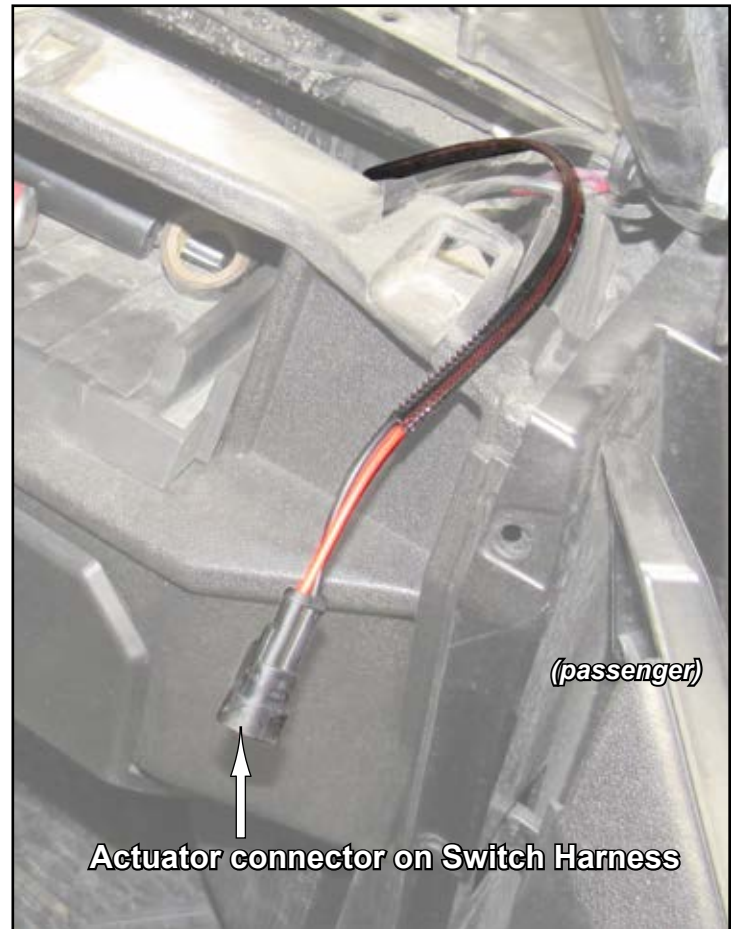




Older models will not have a Terminal Block and will use a stock Power Supply as shown.



- Route Actuator connections to locations shown.



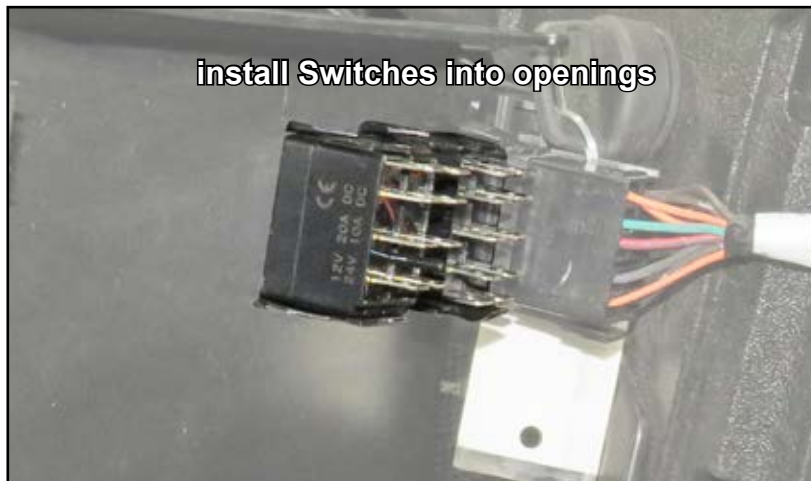


- Repeat for driver side.



Switch Mounting:

- Remove stock Knockouts or cut new locations.
- User may install Switches in locations different than shown.
- Verify that Harnesses will reach Switches before mounting and check behind areas to be cut for any interference.



**if installing Windshield Wiper Kit, ensure that Switches match Harnesses;
don't connect Wiper Harness to Windshield open and close Switch**

Tank Bracket

(passenger footwell)



#8 x 3/4"

approximately 7"

approximately 1-3/4"

- Place Tank Bracket onto Firewall in locations shown.
- Install screw through hole in Tank Bracket; snug but not completely tight.
- Ensure that Tank Bracket is at 1-3/4" dimension shown and install remaining Screw through Slot in Tank Bracket.
- Tighten all hardware.

Windshield Wiper Kit only

- Connect Tank connector to Tank.
- Trim excess Tubing and connect to Tank.



- Slide Tank onto Tank Bracket.



- Cut Wire Guide (F) into 4 pieces; dimensions shown below.
- Place Actuator Wire into Wire Guide (F) and secure Wire Guide (F) to machine in location shown.
