

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Rear Glass Windshield Kit: RGWS-K-RID

- Please look through and read these instructions BEFORE starting so you understand what processes you'll be doing, and possible extra tools you may need.
- Do Not discard product packaging until installation is complete and functioning properly.


1. The first thing you need to do (*if yours is not already installed*) is **Install** the **Clamps** that go onto the windshield. These will go along one edge as shown in **Fig.1a**. **Fig.1b** shows the **Clamps** you will be installing by placing them over the holes in the windshield and using **Two (2) Screws**, **Flat Washers**, **Rubber Washers** and **Nylock Nuts** provided in your kit, in the next step.

2.To install the Clamps. use the Socket Head Screws, Flat Washers and Rubber Sealing Washers on the opposite side of the Windshield the Clamps are on and feed the hardware thru the Windshield and up thru the Clamp Holes. Then install the Nylock Nuts to the Screws. Fig.2a shows the order in which you install the washers onto the screw, and Fig.2b shows the hardware inserted into and up thru the Clamp, Wash-





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3.Next, you need to cut to size and install a small piece of Adhesive Seal to one side of each Clamp, the side that comes in Contact with your vehicle. Fig.3a shows where to place this seal on each of the Clamps. Fig.3b shows Seals Installed. See Fig.3a-b.

4.Once the window is ready, you can now install the Windshield Clamps. Fig.4a shows the Clamp. There are Two (2) Clamps to install. To place them in the general location on the bar, you will need to place them onto the upper rear bar in the position shown in Fig.4b, and measure 8-1/2" from the edge of the vertical framing to the outside surface of the clamp, also shown in Fig.4b. Repeat this same measurement procedure for the opposite side. Once the clamp is in position, lightly snug the screws to hold in place, but don't tighten down as you may need to adjust them the holes on the Windshield in the coming steps. See Fig.4c.



5.Now find the Windshield Brackets as shown in Fig.5a. Then mount it to the Clamp you just installed using the Hex Flanged Bolt from your kit in the orientation shown in Fig.5b-c. (NOTE: We are showing this Clamp and Bracket mounted on the Driver's Side above the back window. The other side will be installed in the same orientation as this one) Repeat these same procedures for the other side Clamp and Bracket.






Fig.6a Fig.6b

6.Next, install the Windshield resting the clamps on the bed frame as shown in **Fig.6a**, pull the top portion of the Windshield towards you tightly up against the window frame, **Fig.6b**, and lock the window in place using the windshield rotating latch handles as shown in **Fig.6c**.
