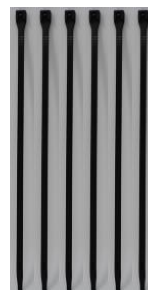

To begin, make sure the vehicle is in park, on level ground and the parking brake is engaged.

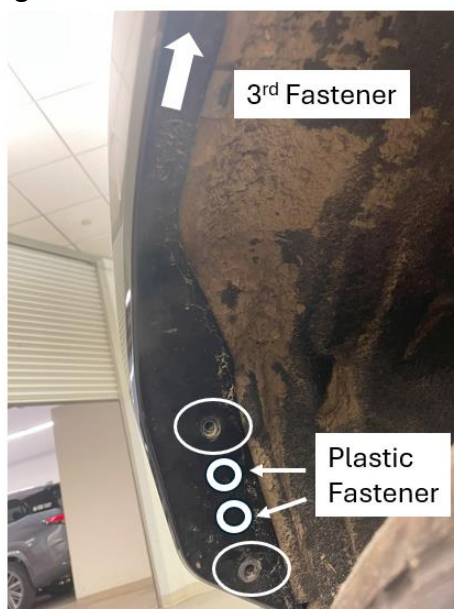
Step 1: Vehicle Prep

Disconnect the negative battery terminal on the vehicle battery using a 10mm socket.



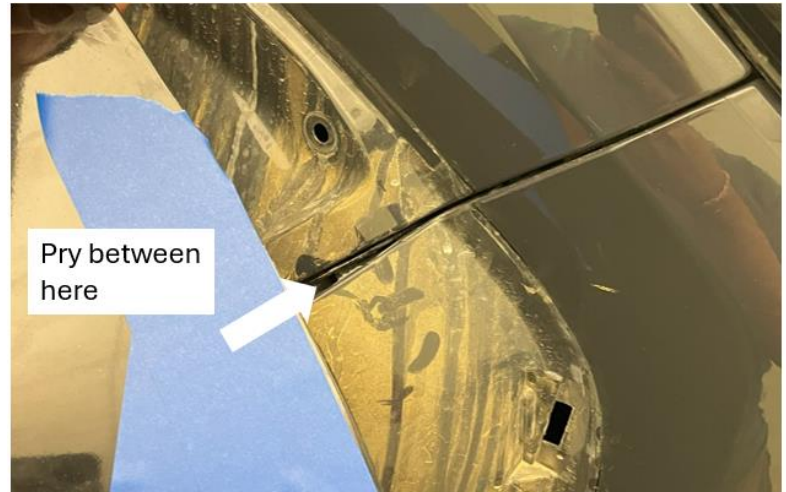
Step 2: Loosen the front fenders

Remove the 3 hex head fasteners on the inside of the fender using a 10mm socket (The third fastener is towards the top of the fender). Some fenders may have two additional plastic fasteners that will need to be removed by prying the head up. Firmly pull the fender corner directly away from the vehicle until you hear the clips disengage.



Step 3: Release the front fascia clips

Pull the corner of the front fascia (that was beneath the front fender) directly outward to free the clips. Pry between the clips to release them using a trim removal tool.



Step 4: Remove fasteners underneath the front fascia

Use a 10mm socket to remove the two fasteners in each corner along the bottom edge of the front fascia. Remove the two bolts accessible from the gap between the fascia and the skid plate.



Step 5: Remove the air intake

Remove the air intake by pushing the 4 clips circled below until they release and pulling them out. Completely remove the air intake and store it somewhere safe.



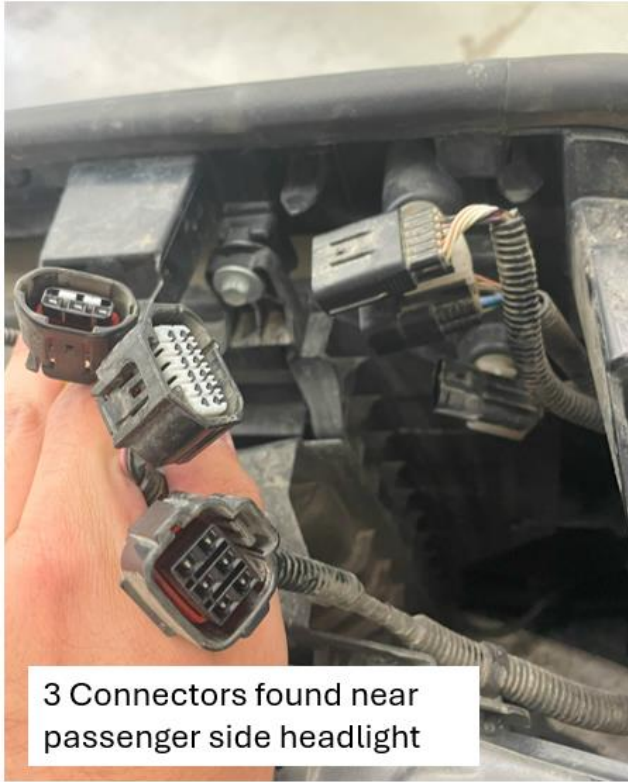
Step 6: Remove under the hood fascia fasteners

Use a 10mm socket to remove the 3X bolts at the locations circled below. Remove the two plastic fasteners (near the hood latch) by pushing the center and pulling them out.

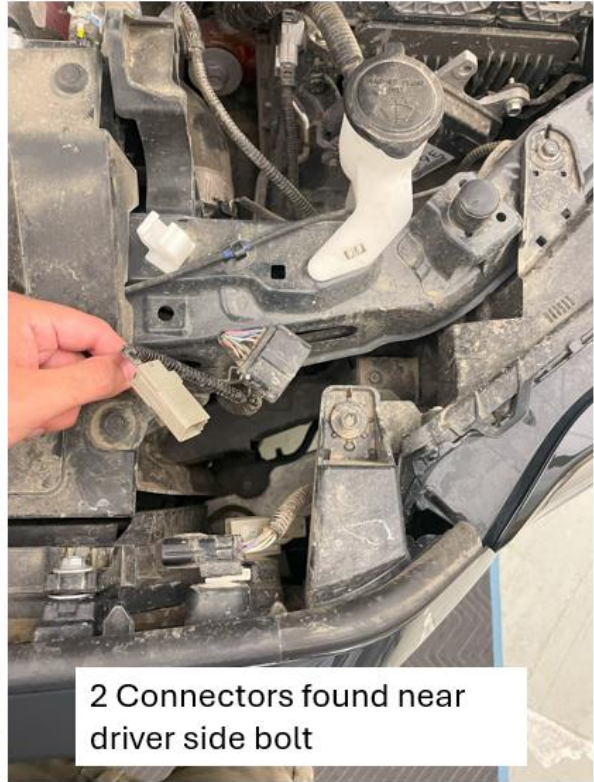


Step 7: Disconnect all connectors going to the front fascia/grill

Disconnect the 3 connectors found near the passenger side headlight/beneath the intake. Disconnect the two connectors found near the driver side bolt pictured above. Tuck them away to avoid pinching during reinstall. **Some vehicles may have less connectors.**

Step 8: Remove the front fascia

Tape the bottom edge of the headlight to avoid scratches

With an assistant, Pull the front grill/fascia straight off the vehicle. Make sure to clear the locating nub on each mount from step 6.



Step 9: Remove vent trim panel (both sides)

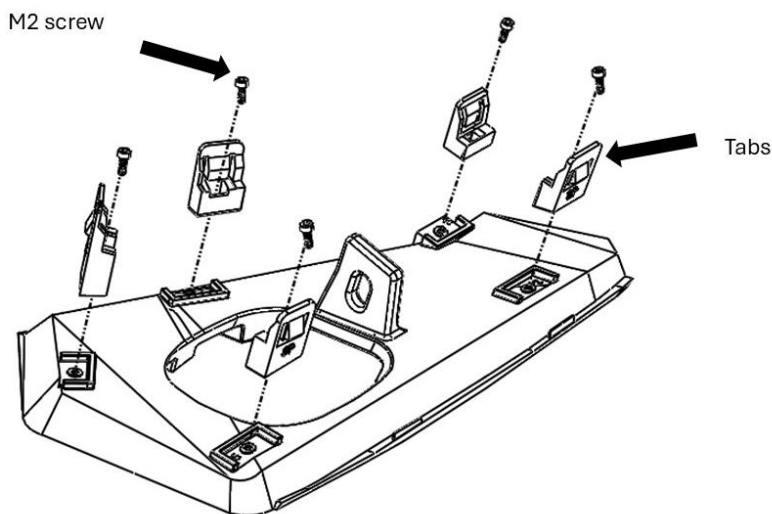
Disengage the five clips (pictured below) on each trim panel (Both sides).



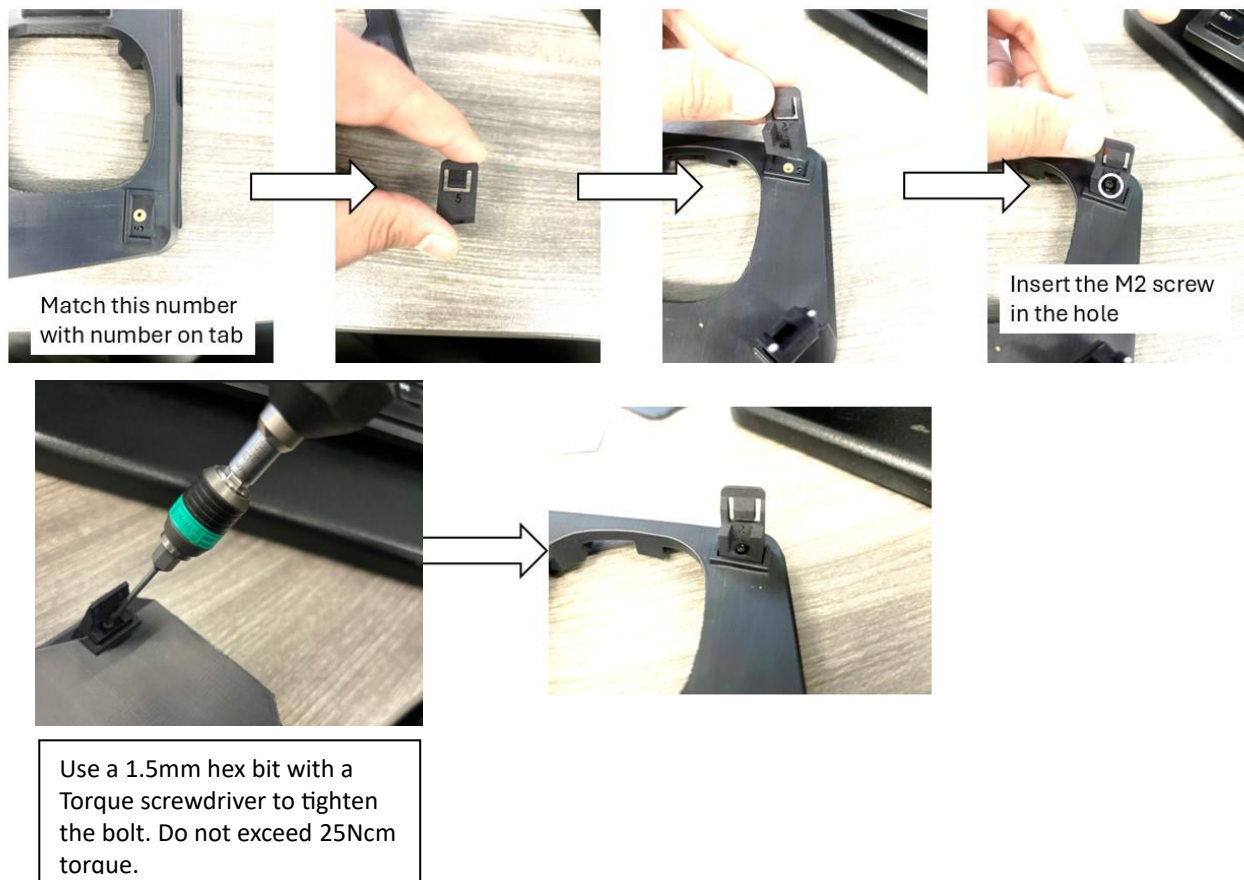
Step 10: Insert tabs in the base bracket

Use below given image to insert the tabs in the base bracket for passenger side and driver side.

***THE TABS ARE DELICATE SO PLEASE DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN THEM.
USE A TORQUE SCREWDRIVER AND DO NOT EXCEED 25 Ncm TORQUE.**



The tabs and the base bracket have initials P and D embossed on their surface to recognize which is Passenger and Driver.



Step 11: Install the vent bracket

Insert the vent kit in place of the OEM bracket. Make sure all the tabs are inserted in the correct slots.

***DO NOT PUSH/FORCE THE BRACKET IN, BEFORE MAKING SURE THAT ALL THE TABS ARE PROPERLY ALIGNED AND CLEAR THE SLOTS EASILY.**

Once the tabs are nicely aligned, gently push the bracket by applying equal force from all sides. The tabs will lock in once inserted. At this point, begin gently pushing the brackets on the corners so the tabs can properly engage. After confirming that the tabs are inserted, make sure all the tabs have completely passed the slots and are engaged.

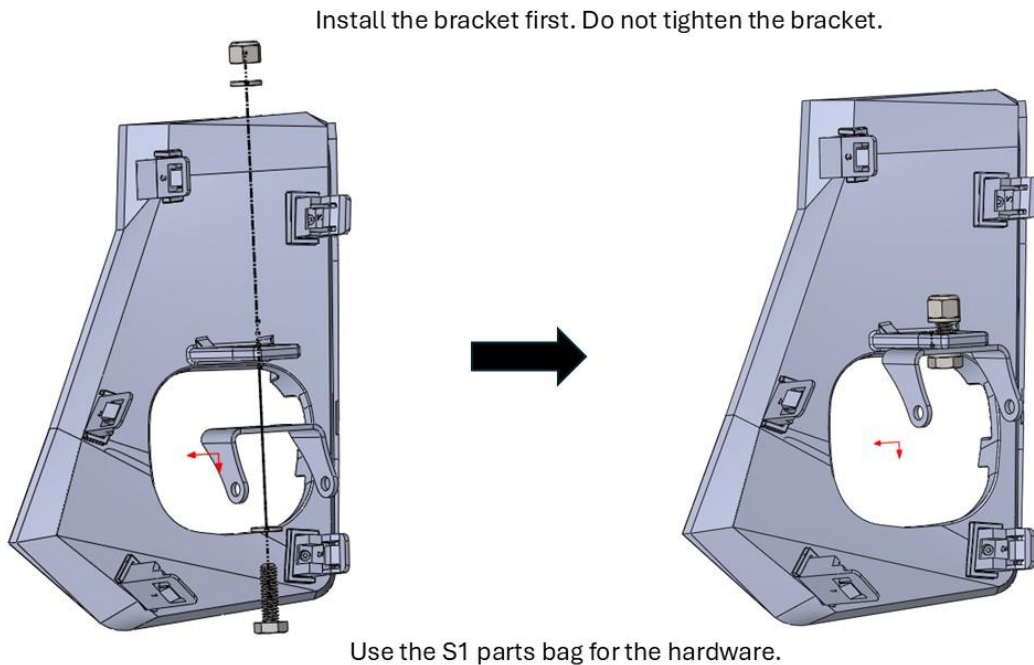

Step 12: Install the light

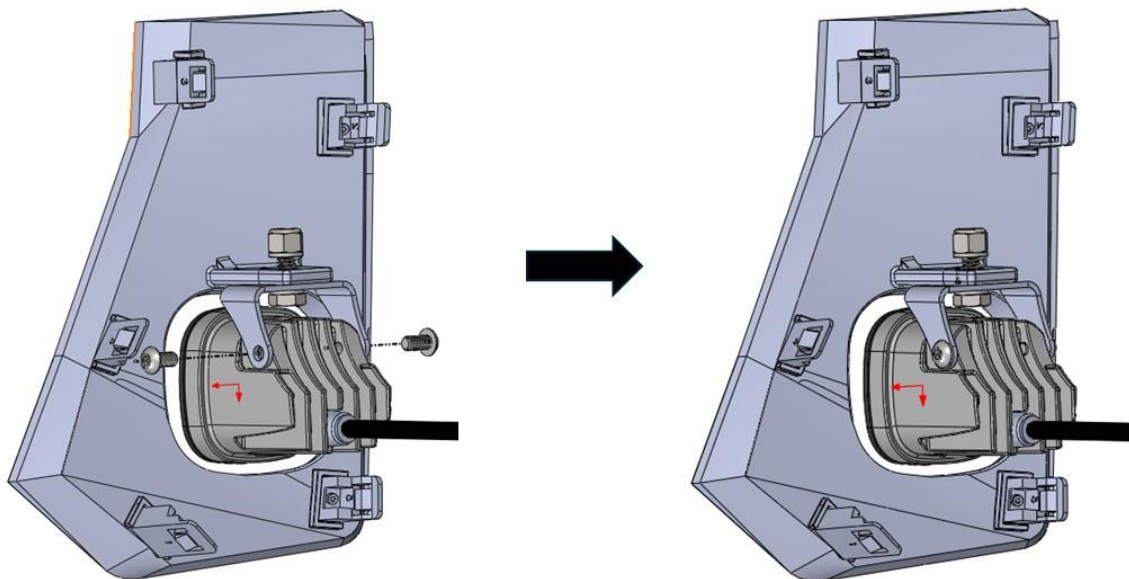
***THE BRACKET IS ALREADY INSTALLED ON THE BUMPER IN THE PREVIOUS STEP, THIS IS A CAD IMAGE SO IT DOES NOT HAVE BUMPER IN THE BACKGROUND. DO NOT INSTALL LIGHTS ON THE BRACKET BEFORE MOUNTING THE BRACKET ON THE BUMPER.**

Use the hardware and the bracket in the parts bag to mount the light into the vent bracket. Use 7/16" wrench and socket.



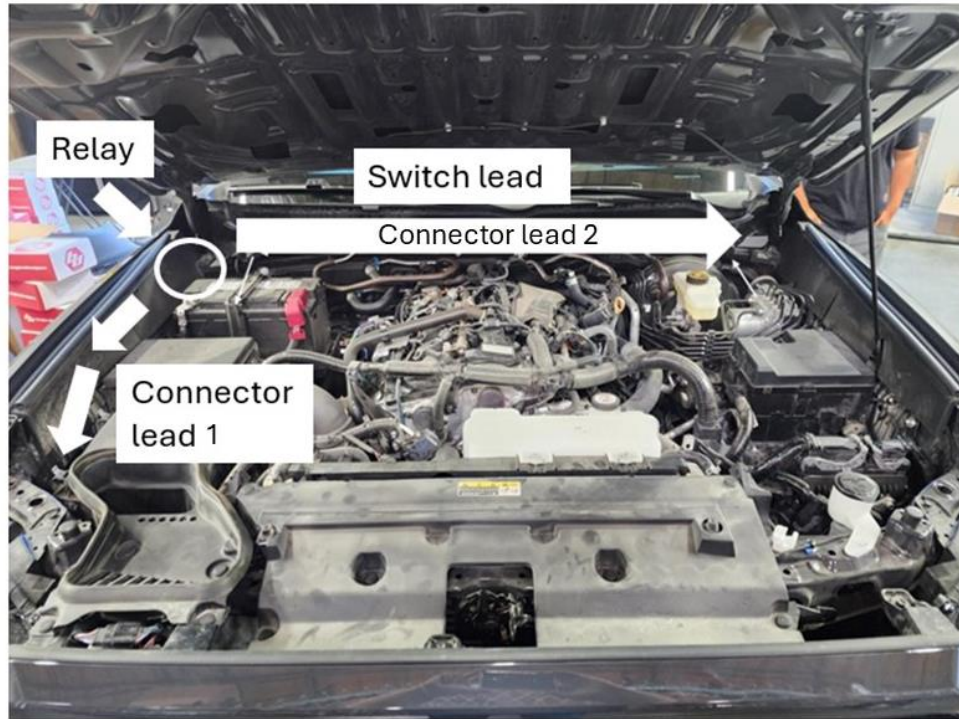
Use a 3mm hex key to tighten the bolts that connects the light to the mounting bracket.

Install the light on to the bracket. Adjust the light and then tighten the mounting bracket bolt.



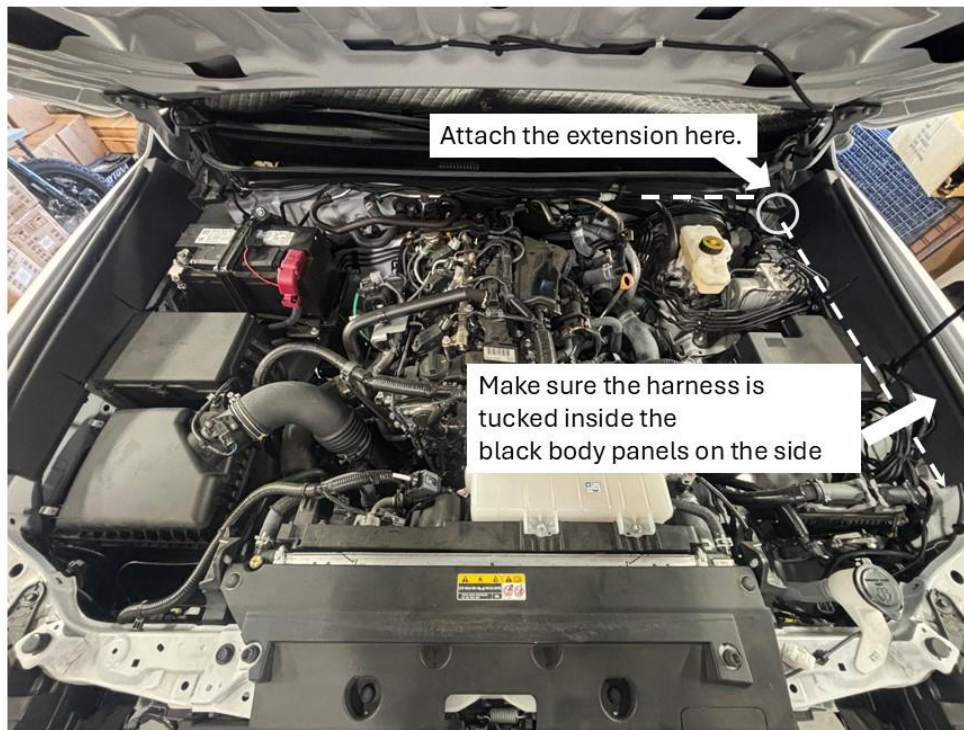
Step 13: Harness prep

Secure the harness to the battery terminals using 12mm wrench. Loosely secure them around the vehicle battery. Run the switch lead along the firewall towards the driver's side. Run one of the connectors towards the front of the vehicle and underneath the air intake for the passenger side light. Refer to the image below and step 13 for connecting lead 2 to the driver side light. **DO NOT RECONNECT THE VEHICLE BATTERY.**



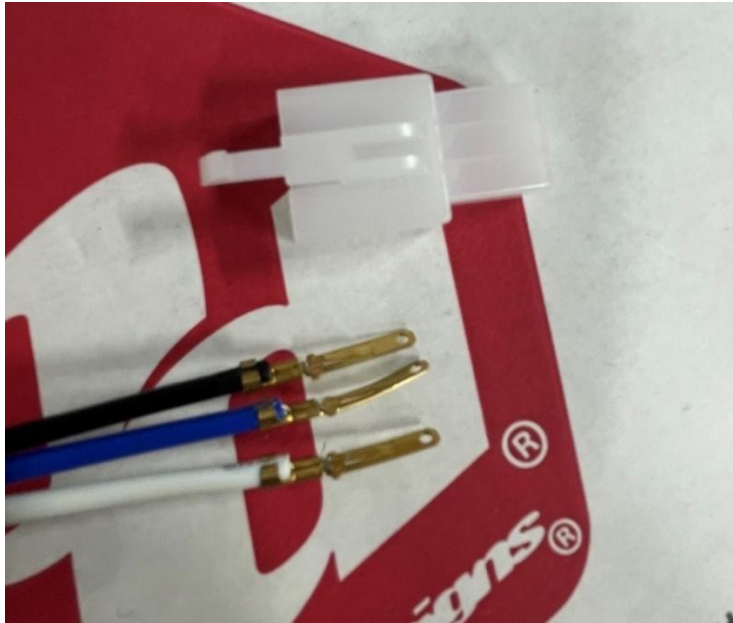
Step 14: Connecting an extension

For reaching the driver side, connect the main harness (64-0117) to the 10ft extension (64-0165). Use the diagram below for reference.



Step 15: Toggle Version ONLY (Skip to step 21 for upfitter version)

Disconnect the white connector on the switch lead and remove the connector from the switch side leaving the pins exposed. Use a tiny flat head or unfolded paper clip to de-pin.



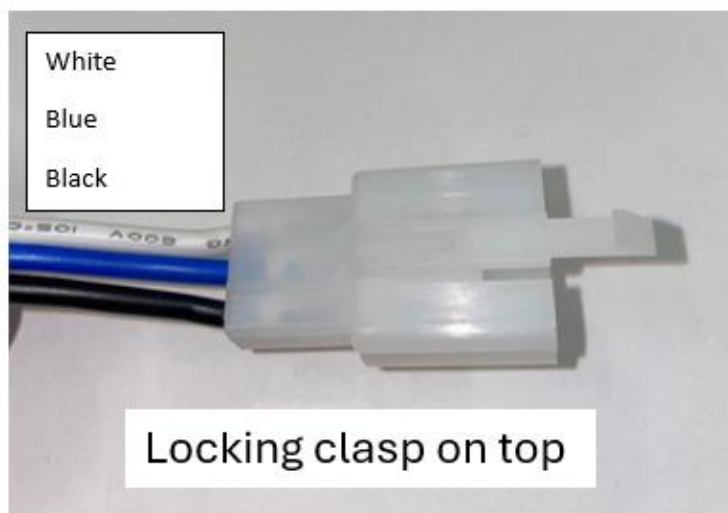
Step 16: Firewall passthrough

Make a small hole in the firewall passthrough and pass the switch lead connector through the boot into the engine bay (pin side first). Wire emerges below the brake booster (driver side).



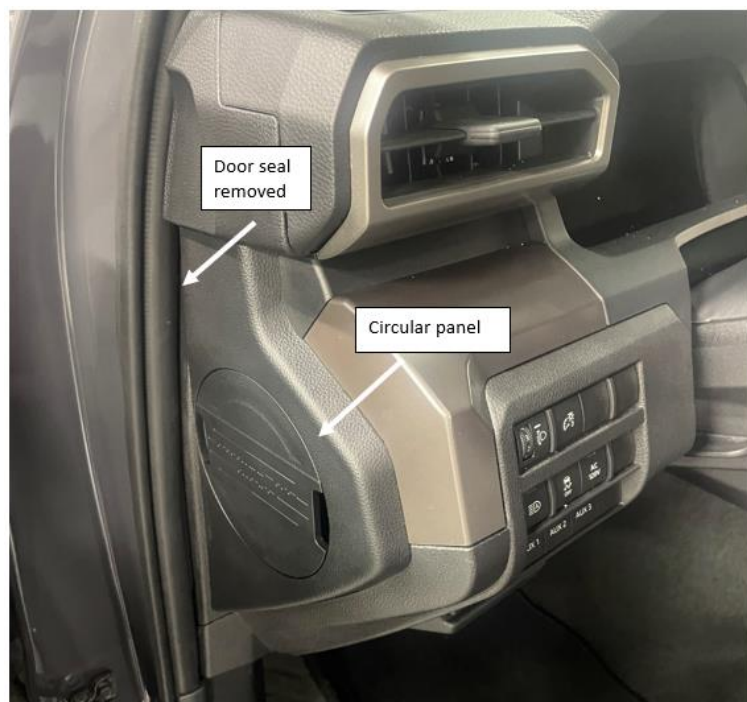
Step 17: Harness reconnection

Pull the switch lead into the engine bay until it is long enough to be reconnected to the original harness. Re-install the white connector onto the exposed pins using the format below and then reconnect the two harnesses.



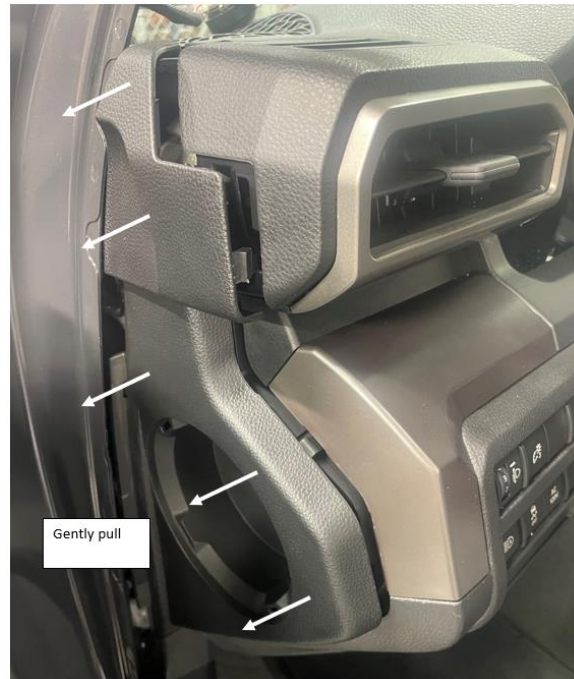
Step 18: Trim panel removal

Remove the door seal on the driver's side and the round trim panel pictured below.



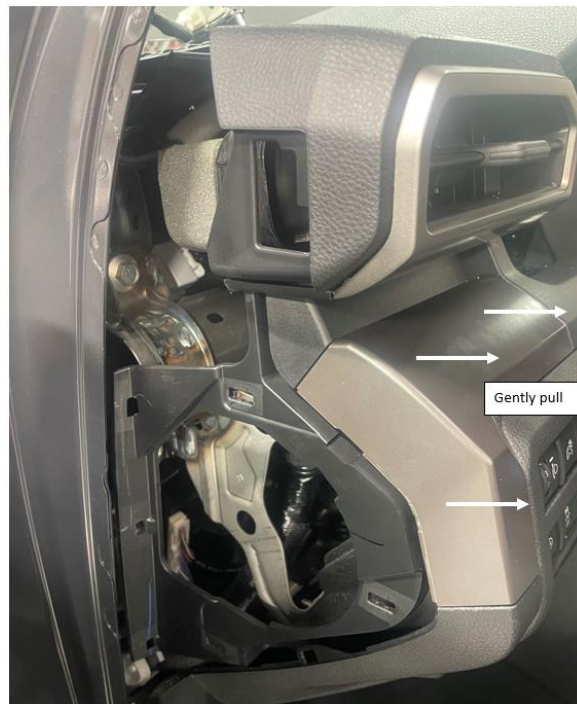
Step 19: Trim panel removal

Remove the trim panel off the side of the dashboard by starting at the top edge and gently pulling away from the dash.



Step 20: Trim panel removed

Remove the trim panel by pulling parallel to the arrows pictured.

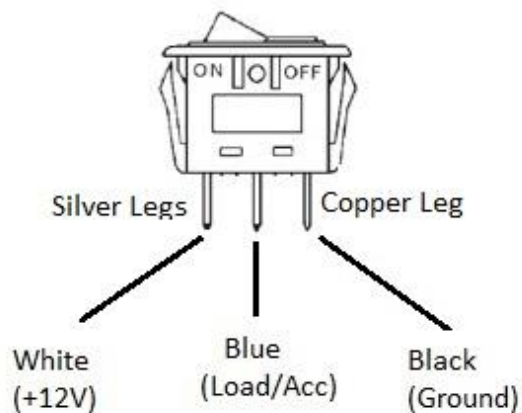


Step 21: Button Installation

Drill a hole .75" in diameter at the specified location. Remove the button from the switch harness leaving only the exposed pins. Run the harness up from the footwell behind the dash and into the newly made hole. Re-install the button onto the harness and place it onto the dashboard. Re-install all trim panels.



BD Lighted Rocker

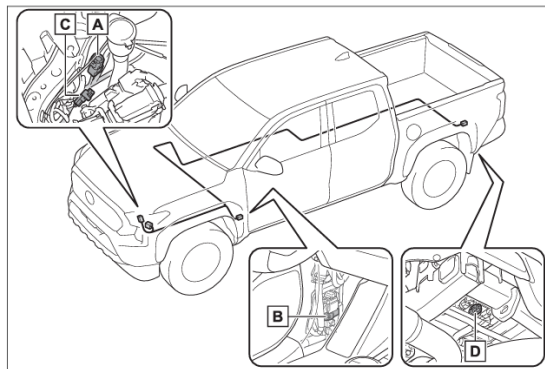

Step 22: Upfitter Kits ONLY

Remove the OEM connector plug A from the harness behind the driver side headlight.

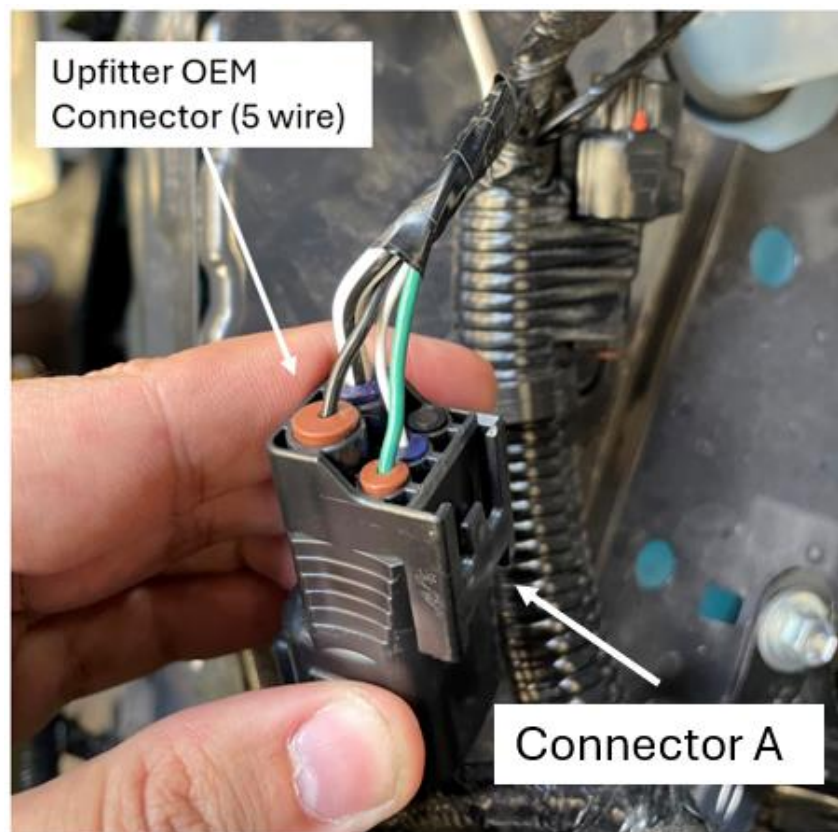
Location of auxiliary switch wire harness connectors:

- D** Rear frame

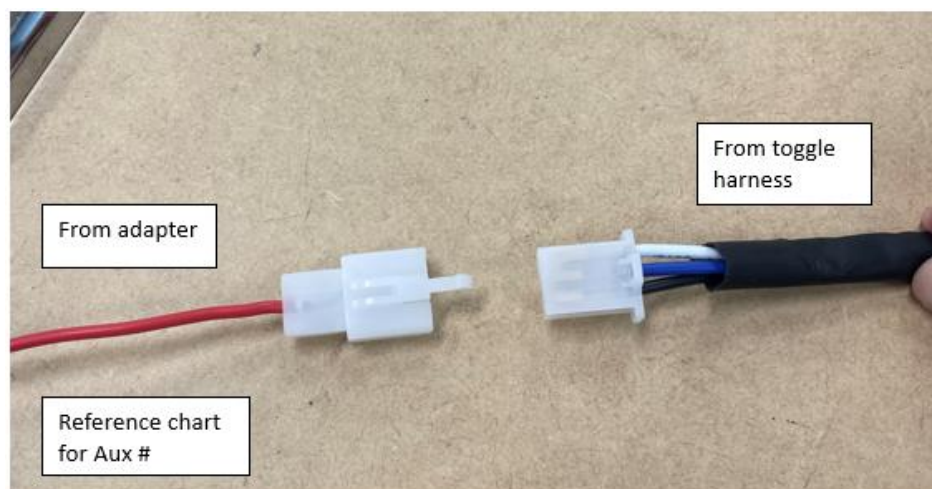
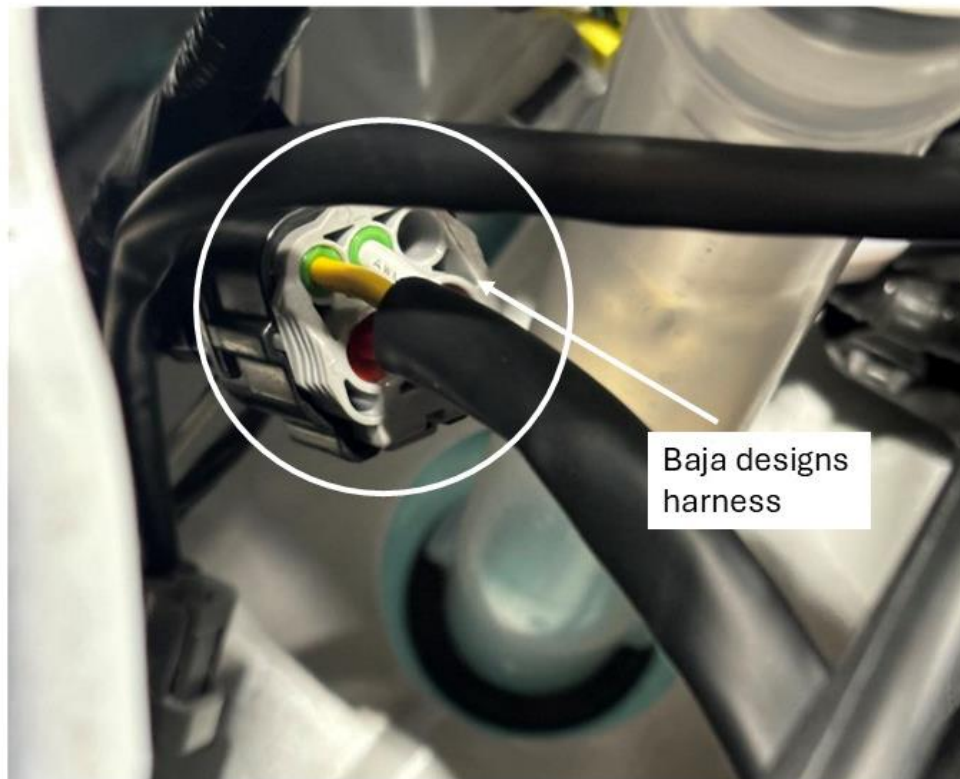

Step 23: Upfitter harness routing (Upfitter only)

Plug in the provided adapter (60-0101 to be bought separately) and run the harness to the end of the toggle harness in step 12. Connect the two harnesses using the appropriate connector from the chart below. Tie away any slack using the zip ties provided.



Depending on which Auxiliary (Aux) button you want to control your lights follow the reference below:

Aux 1: Connect your harness to red wire (Baja Designs adapter) (Pictured above)

Aux 2: Connect your harness to yellow wire (Baja Designs adapter)

Aux 3: Connect your harness to white wire (Baja Designs adapter)

Step 24: Connecting to lights

Connect the harness to the light power cords. Secure the harness as tight to the bracket as possible to clear the shutter system. Use zip-ties to secure the harness.

**Step 25: Reinstall all vehicle body panels**

Reinstall all the body panels by following steps 2-9 in reverse. Reinstall all the fasteners.

Step 26: Testing

Re-connect the 5X connectors from step 7. Re-connect the battery terminals using 12 mm wrench. Test the light functionality for S1s.

Step 27: Installation complete!

*Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.

* Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
