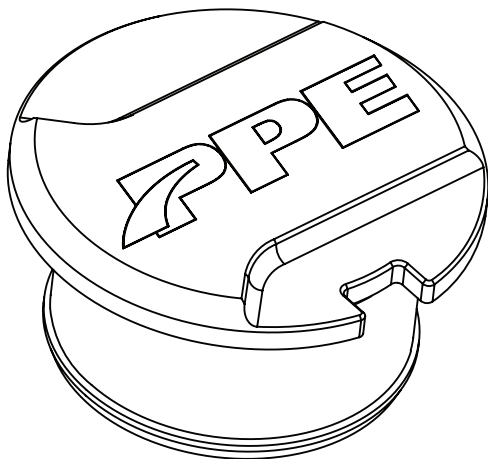




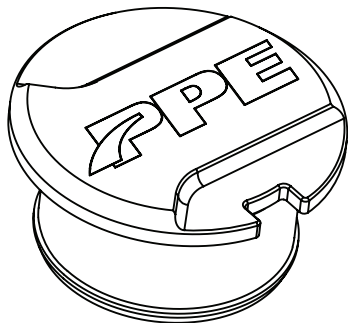
Turbo Resonator Delete Plug

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Installation Guide



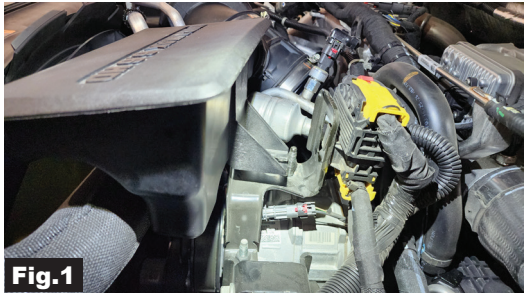
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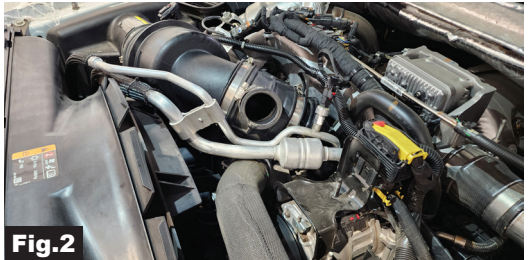
A *Resonator Delete Plug*

INSTALLATION:

1. *Park truck securely and turn off ignition.*
2. *With a 13 mm socket, remove the nut that holds the stock resonator box to the steel bracket. **Fig.1***



3. *Loosen the clamp that secures the resonator box to the air duct. Then remove the resonator **Fig.2***



4. *Install the PPE resonator delete plug. Push in all the way till the cap is in contact with the air duct. **Fig.3***



5. *Tighten the clamp down. **Fig.4***

Installation is now complete.
