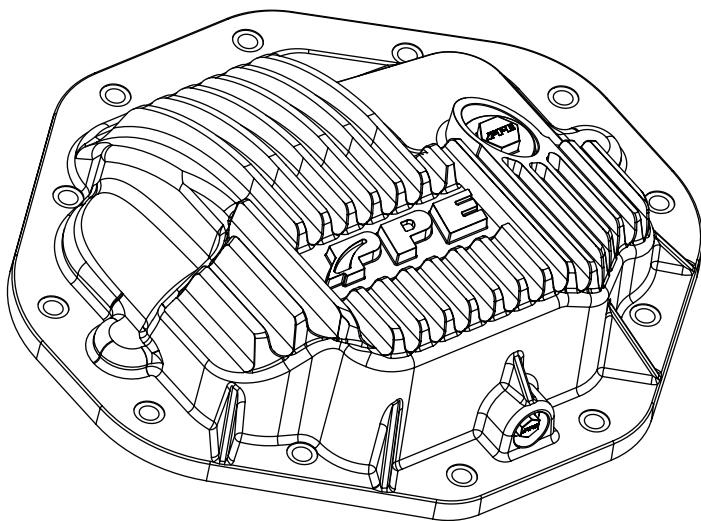
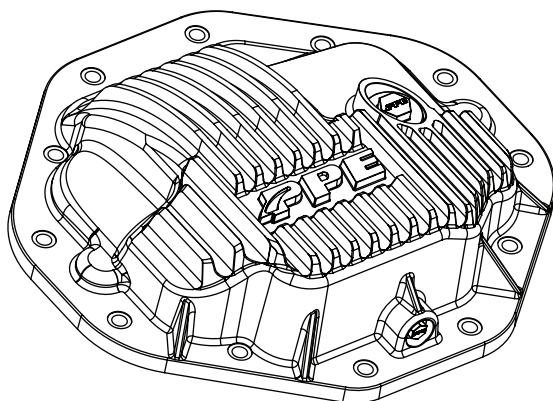




Heavy-Duty Cast Aluminum Rear Differential Cover

Installation Guide

CONTENTS:

- A** (1) *PPE Rear Differential Cover*
- B** (1) *Neodymium Magnet-equipped Fill Plug (installed)*
- C** (1) *Neodymium Magnet-equipped Drain Plug (installed)*
- D** (12) *Socket Head Cap Screws*

INSTALLATION:

1. Vehicle off, secure, and cool.
2. Remove the four bolts securing rear sway bar. **Fig.1**
3. Drain the diff fluid from either the integrated drain plug in housing or remove hardware from cover. **Fig.2**
4. Thoroughly clean old sealant and fluid from the pan housing mating surface. **Fig.3**
5. Apply a continuous bead of RTV sealant onto the PPE diff cover flange and around bolt holes. **Fig.4**

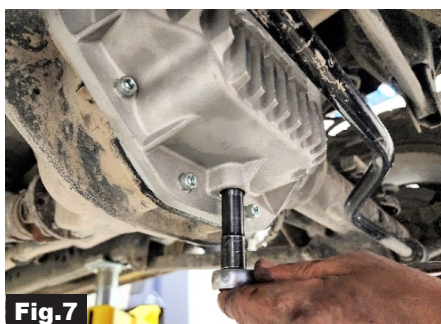
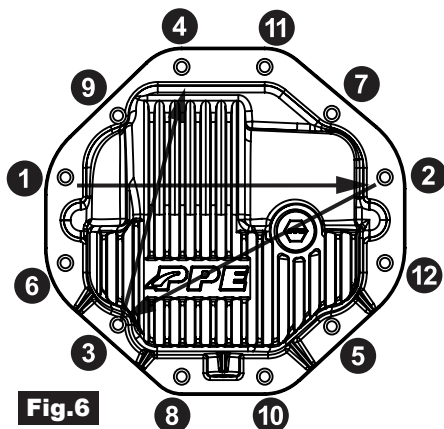
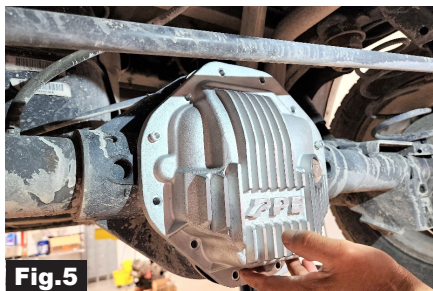




6. Position diff cover in place **Fig.5**, and do not smear the RTV. Install two of the supplied socket head cap screws (D) on each side of the diff cover in positions 1 & 2 (**Fig.6**) for alignment. Finger tight for now.
7. Install all remaining screws (D) finger tight, then torque to 20 lb-ft following the crossing pattern as shown in **Fig.6**.

NOTE: Allow for RTV manufacturer's recommended time for silicone setup.

8. Torque Drain Plug (C) to 15-18 lb-ft. **Fig.7**

- 9: *Fill with manufacturer recommended fluid.*

*Torque Fill Plug to (B) 23-25 lb-ft.
Check for leaks.*



10. *Reinstall the four bolts to the sway bar.*



This completes the installation.
